DE/FR/UK/US Waves 1-9 Trends

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METHODS NOTE

The data here are from the combined waves 1-9 Aid Attitudes Tracker surveys of France, Germany, Great Britain and the United States.

The plots in this deck calculate average response levels for each question using the full sample for each waves, irrespective of whether the respondents are new (have never participated in the AAT survey study) or old (have participated in all or some of previous waves).

Each slide contains two plots.

- The larger plot (on the left) uses the full range of response options on the Y axis, which makes clear long-term trends.
- The smaller plot (on the right) uses a reduced range of response options, which makes visible, short-term, wave-on-wave change.

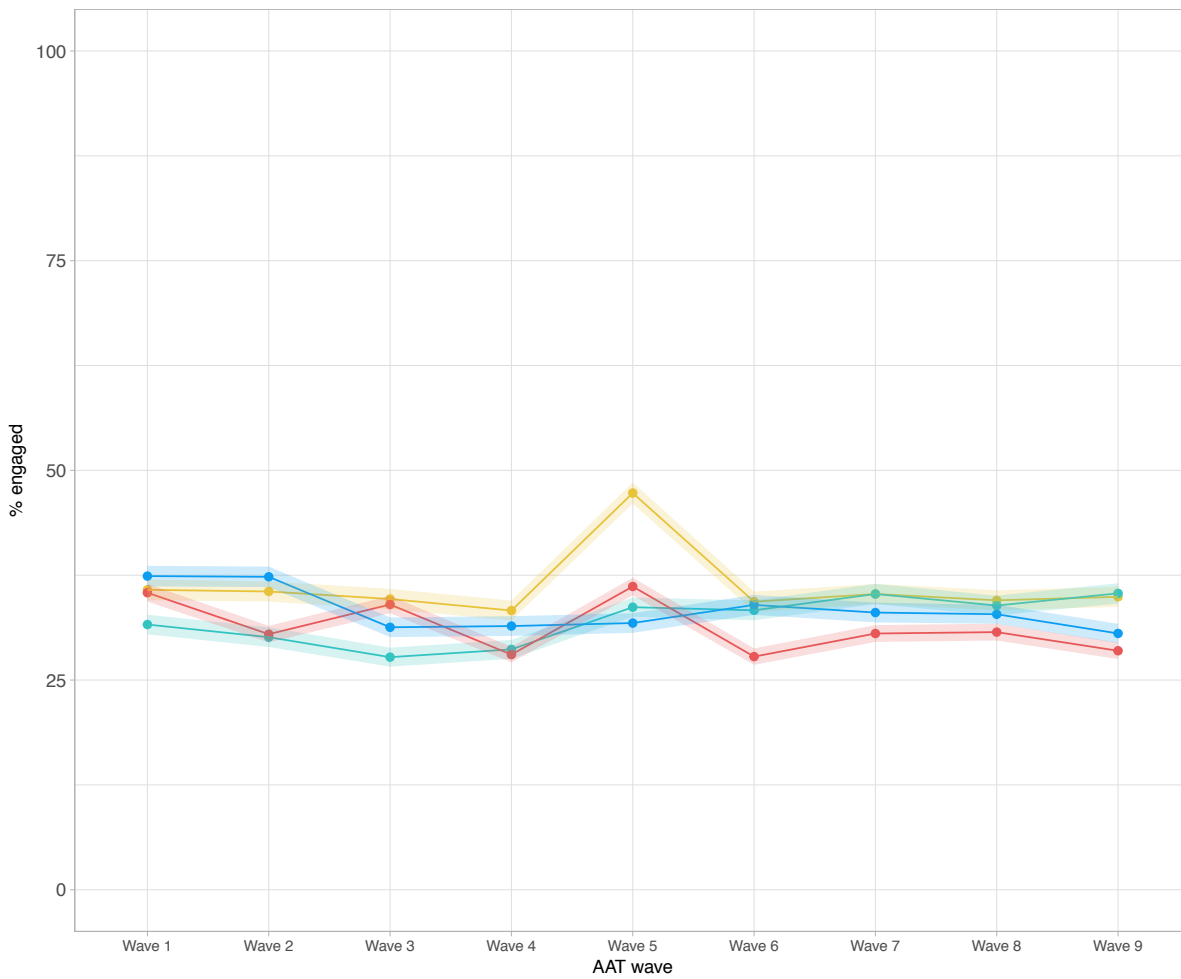

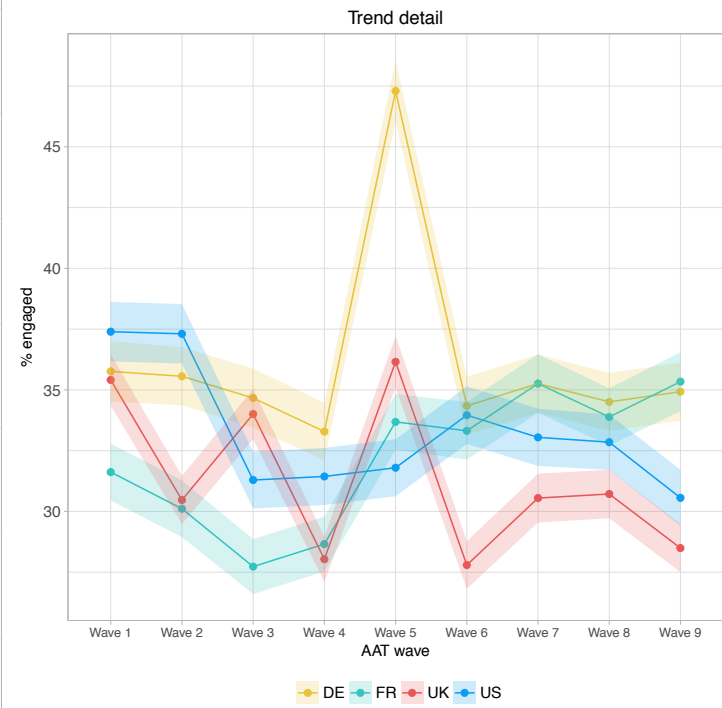

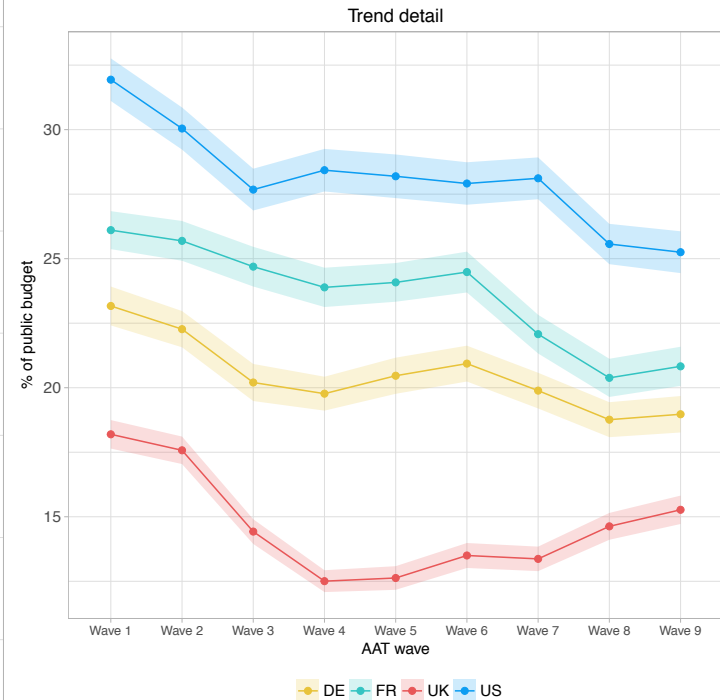

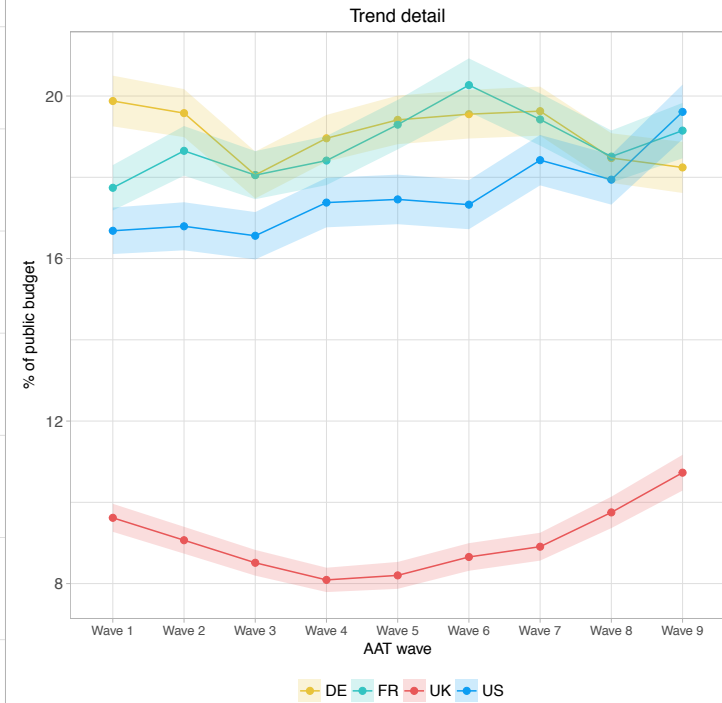

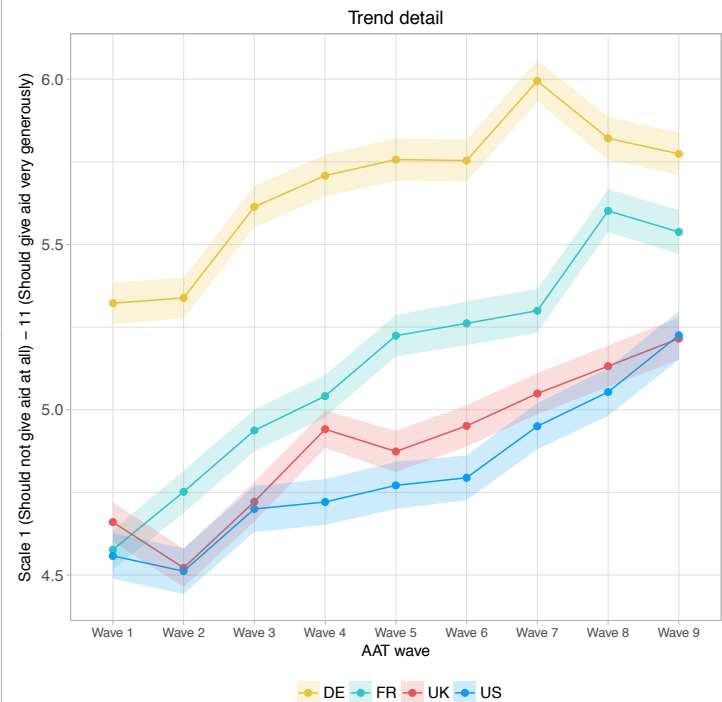
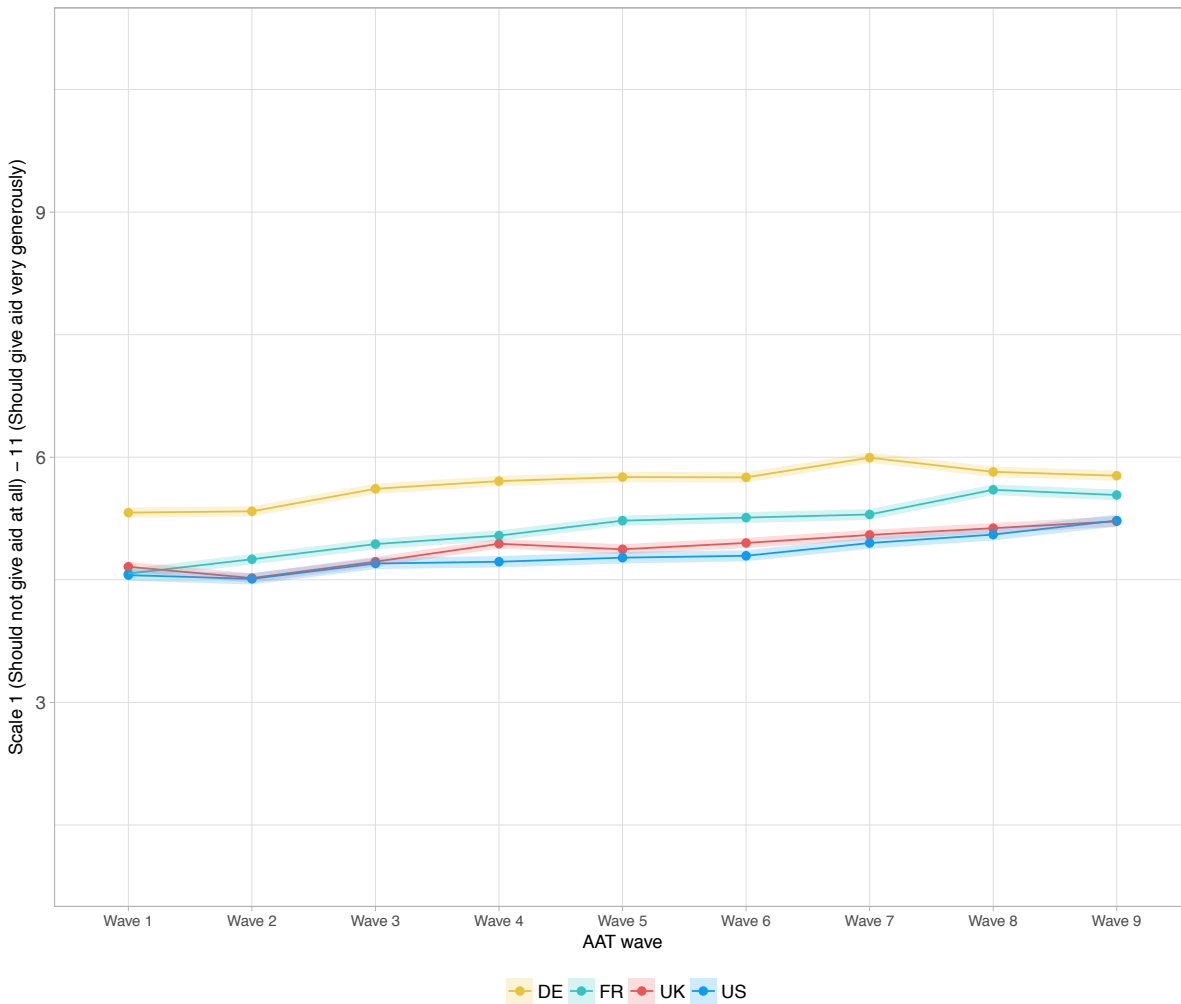
Q4: What per cent of the national budget do you think the DE/FR/UK/US Government currently spends each year on overseas aid?



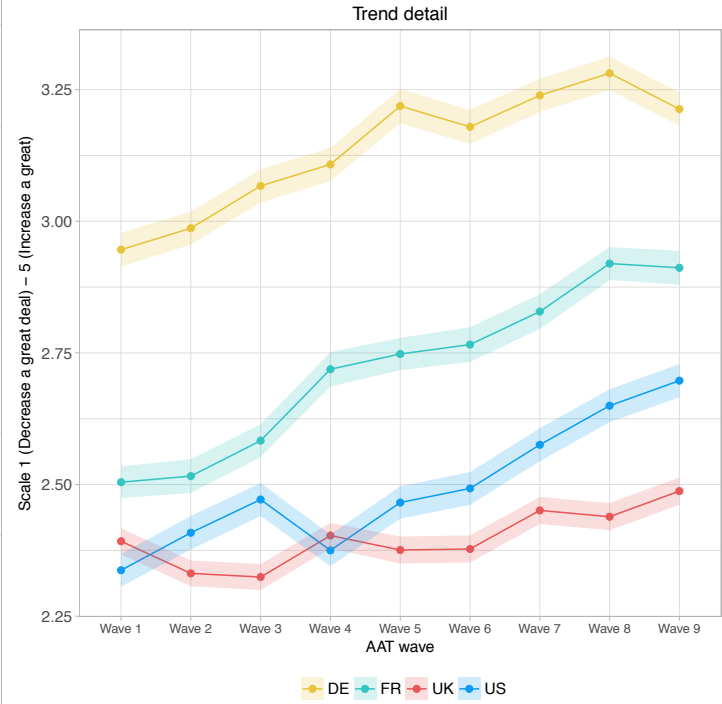
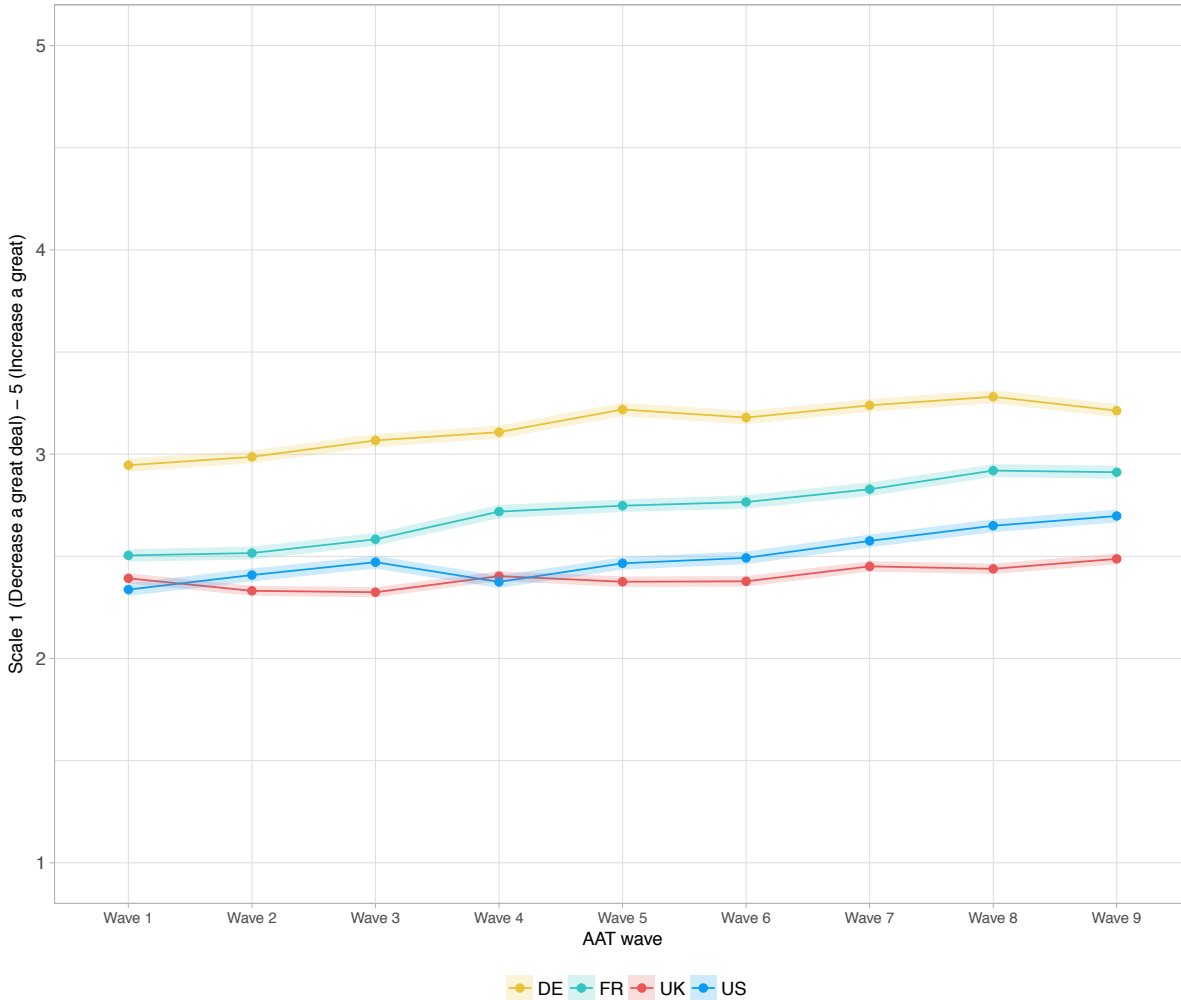
Q5: What per cent of the national budget do you think the DE/FR/UK/US Government should spends each year on overseas aid?



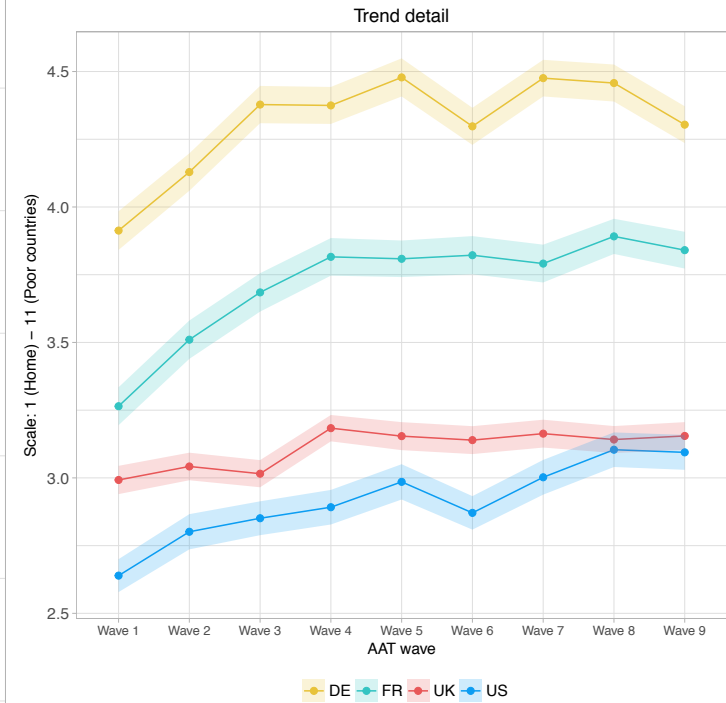
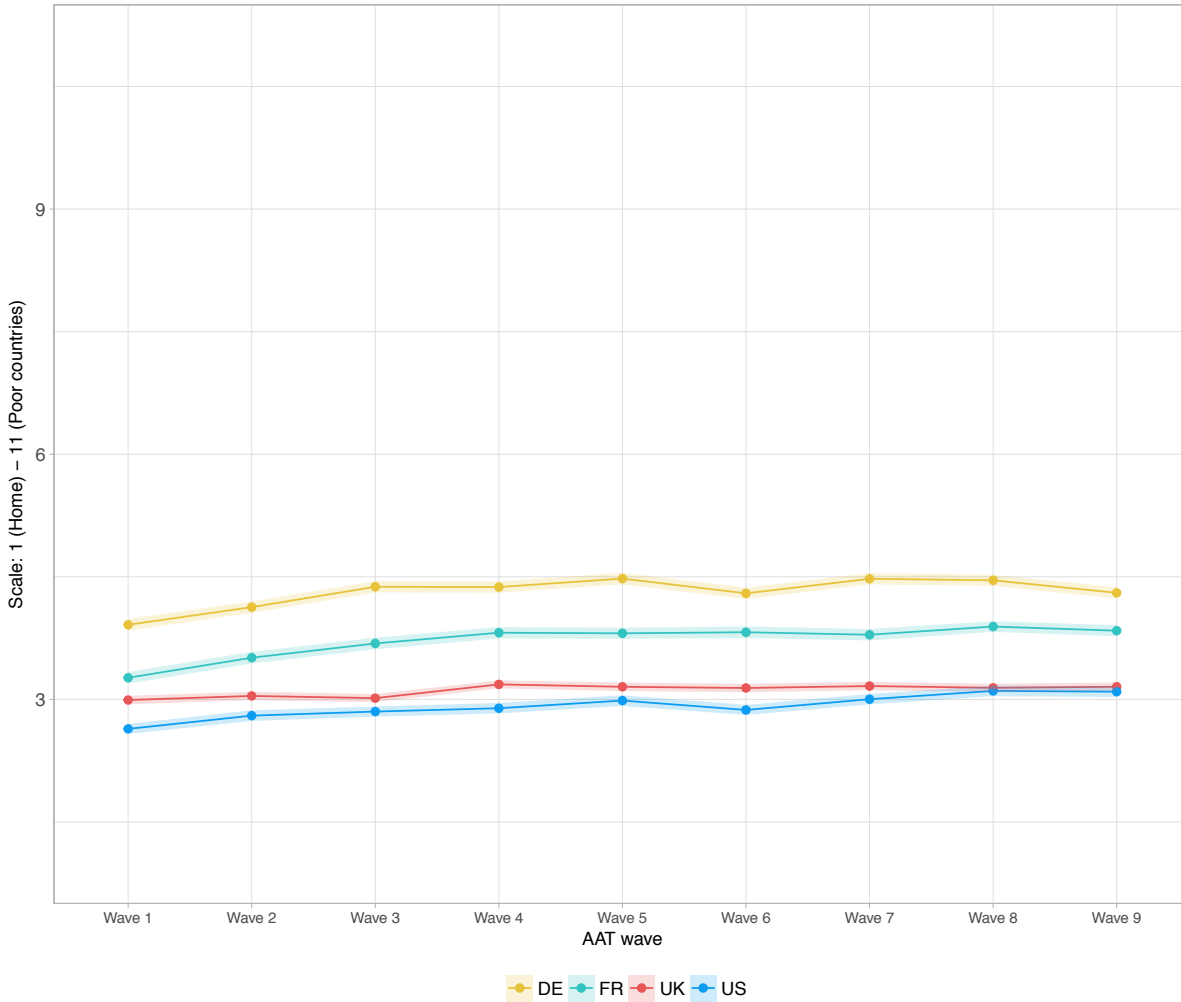
Q6: Thinking about overseas aid to poor countries – please indicate the extent to which you think that the DE/FR/UK/US Government should give overseas?



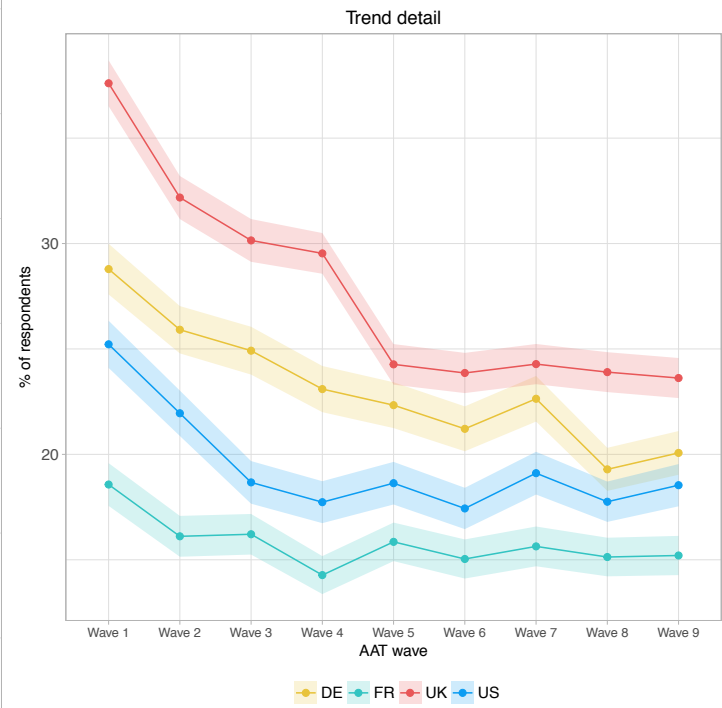
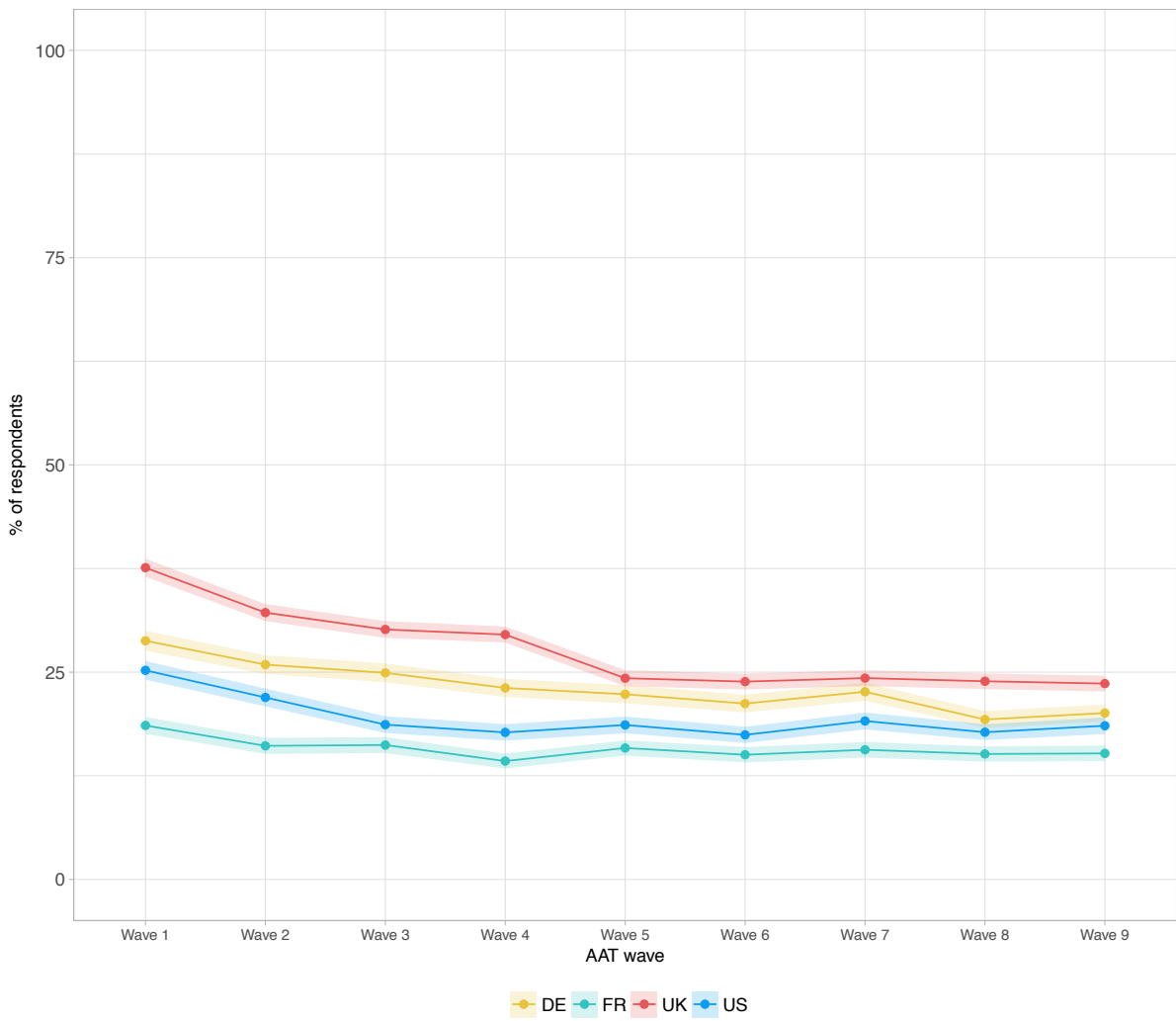
Q7: Do you think that the Government should increase or decrease the amount of money that it spends on overseas aid?



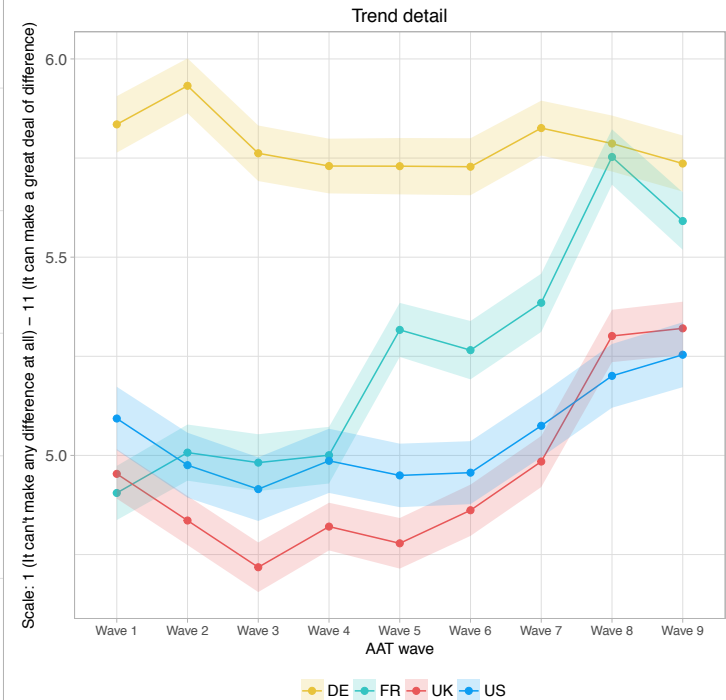
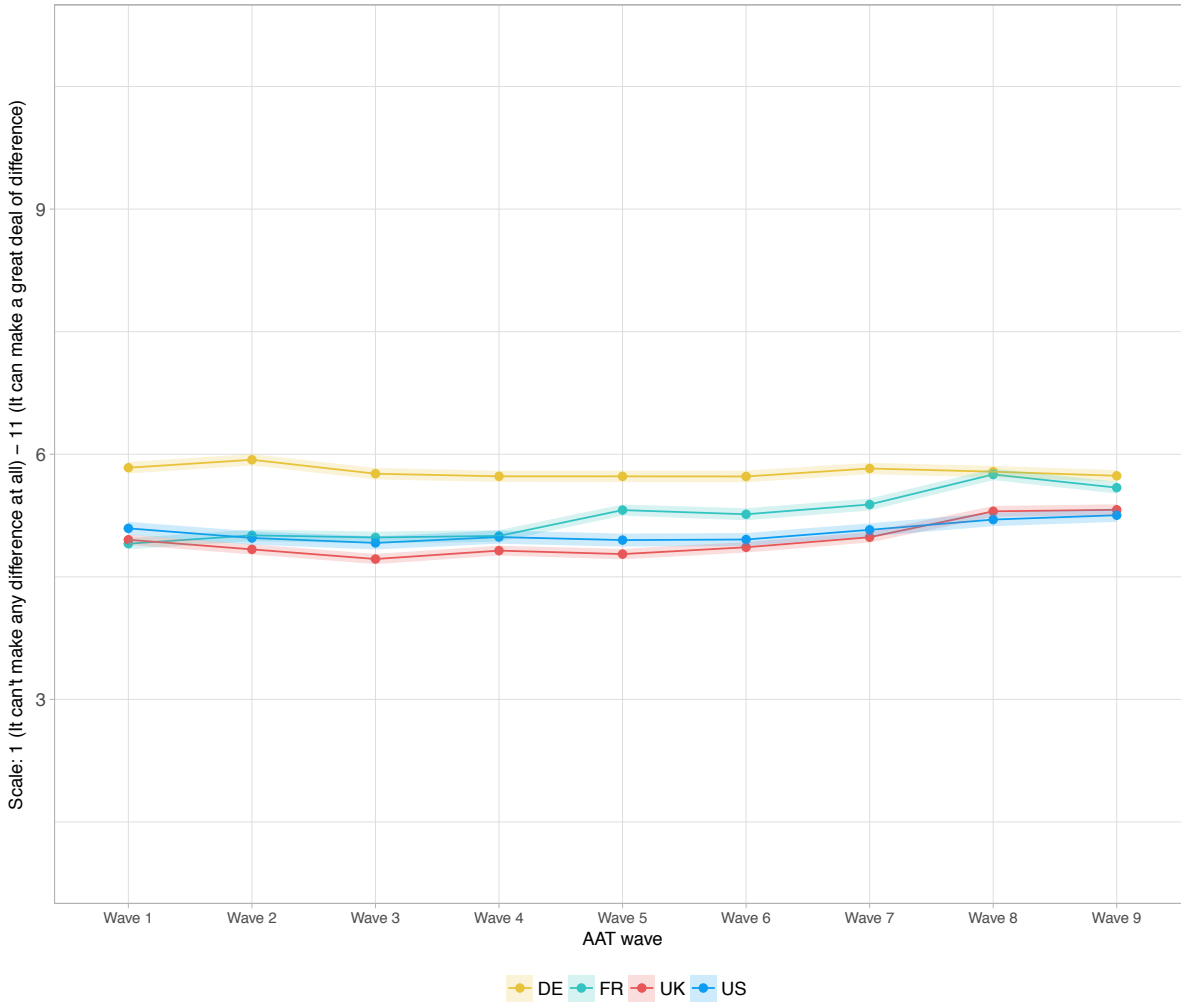
Q8: Do you think that the Government should give higher priority to reducing poverty in poor countries or should it give higher priority to reducing poverty in DE/FR/UK/US?



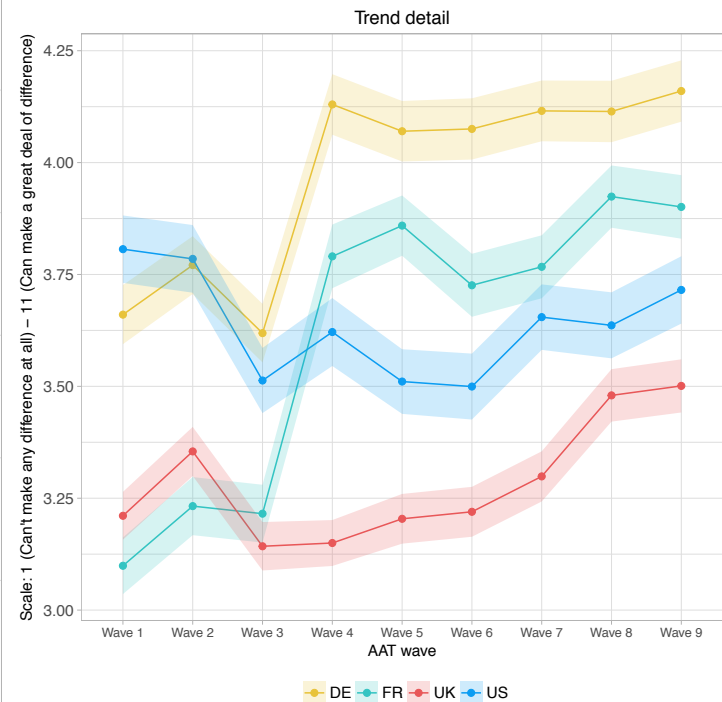
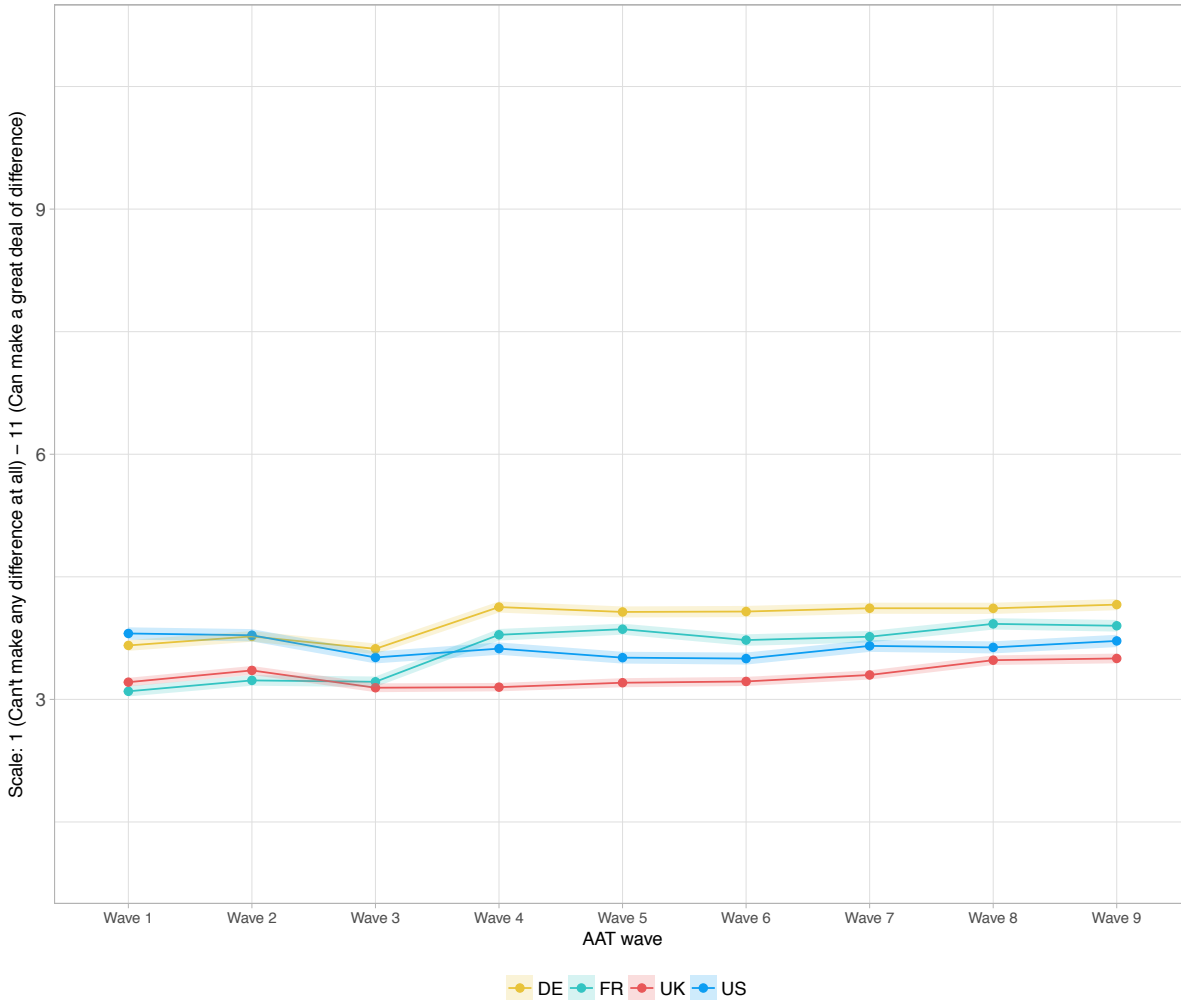
Q12.1: Percentage of respondents who donated in the past year



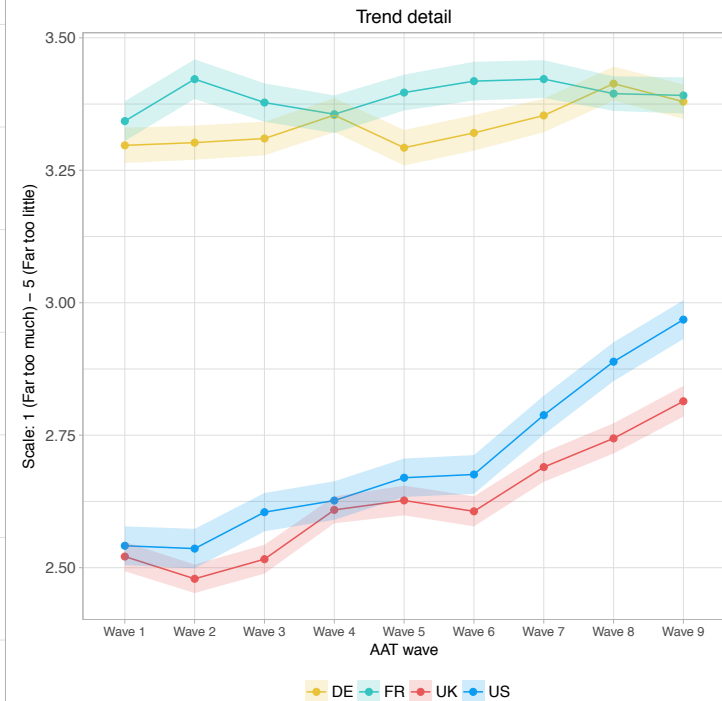
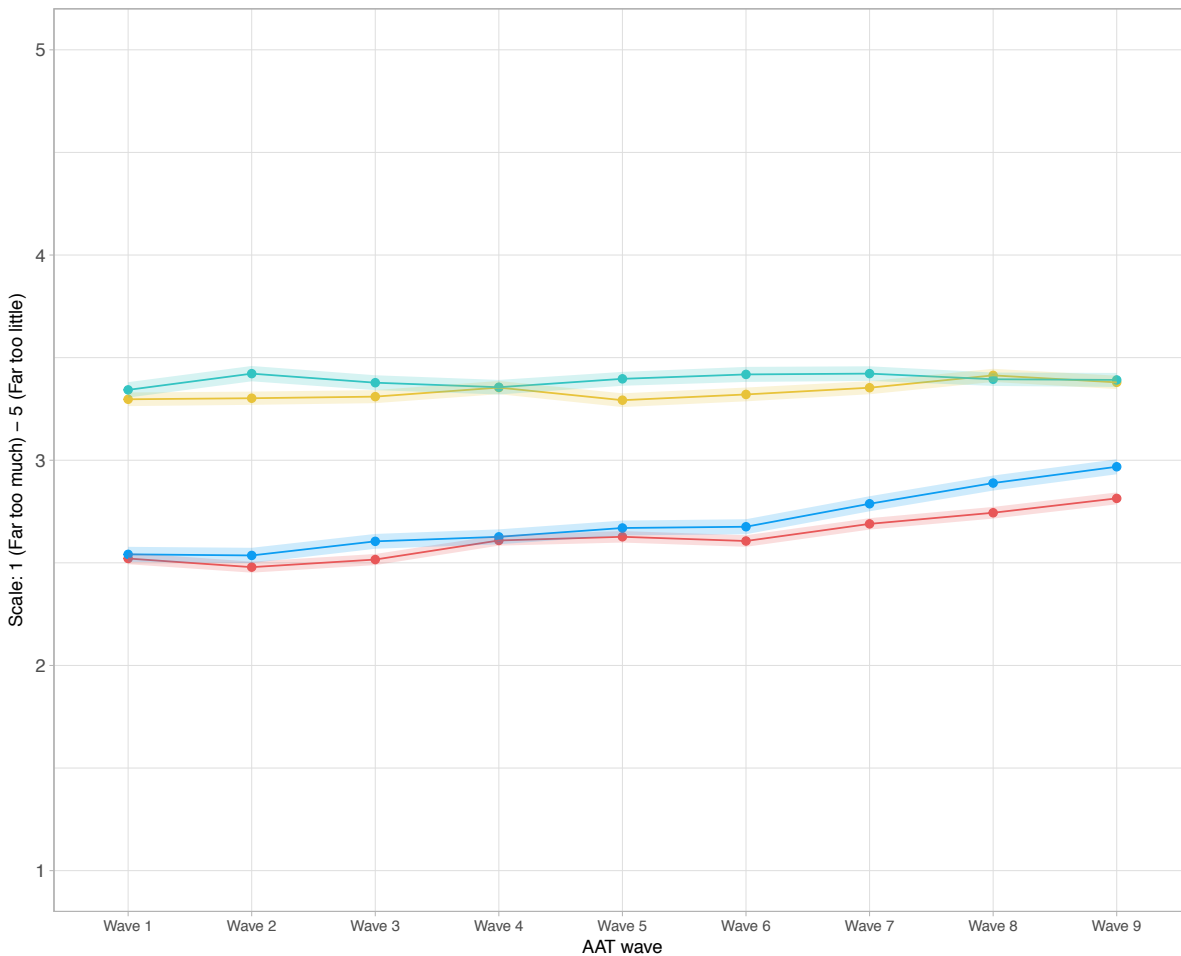
Q19: Thinking about the DE/FR/UK/US Government, how much of a difference do you think it can make to reducing poverty in poor countries?



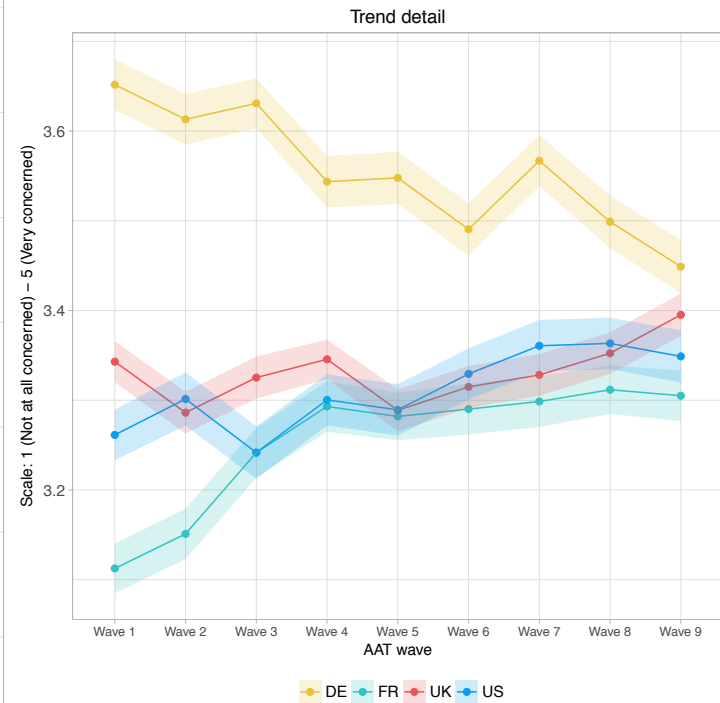
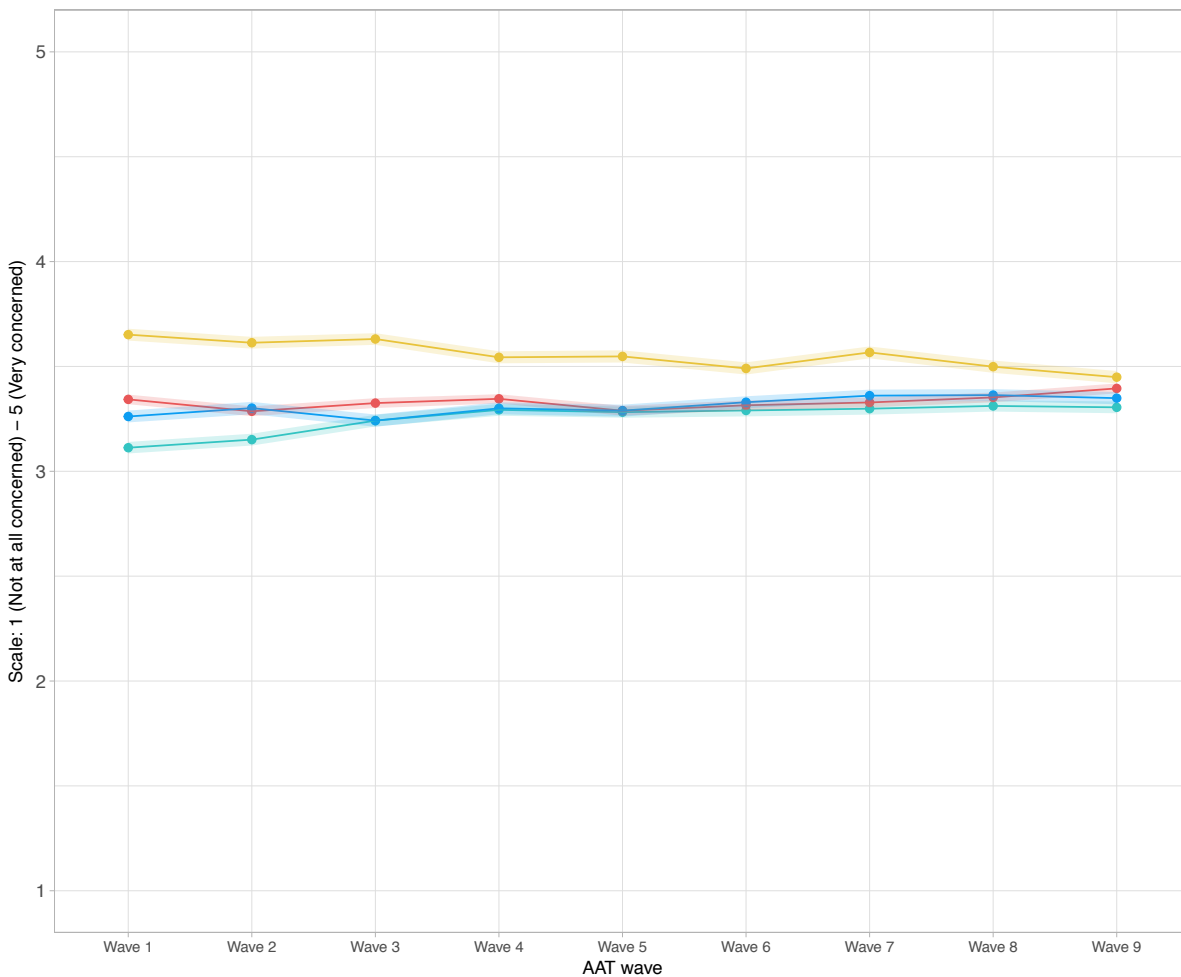
Q21: Thinking about you personally, how much of a difference do you think you can make to reducing poverty in poor countries?
