



## Satisfaction with Macron

Macron has the highest satisfaction ratings on

- France's role in international politics/scene (44%)
- France's role in the EU (40%)
- Fighting terrorism (38%)

} Performs well as  
'international statesman'

He is viewed less well on

- Solving the refugee crisis (21%)
- Africa as a recipient of French aid (27%)
- Action on inequality between men and women (30%)

# With whom is Macron more successful?

France's aid to Africa

- Satisfaction with Macron is driven by older, higher income, more engaged audiences who think *they personally* and *government* can help poor countries
- However, women and better educated are less likely to be satisfied

Trends across issue domains

- **Macron has a woman problem** – across every issue women are less likely to be satisfied with Macron's performance since the election
- **Higher income respondents are more satisfied with Macron on every issue**; same with older respondents (6 of 9 issue areas)
- RN/FN respondents are less likely to be satisfied with Macron on every issue, except aid to Africa
- **Efficacy – both personal and government – matters**: those with 'can make a difference attitude' are *more satisfied with Macron across every issue*




Aid Attitudes Tracker

## Have you ever heard or read about SDGs / United Nations SDGs?

- When asking just about SDGs, more than half of respondents say they have heard or read about
- Falls to 40% when mentioning the UN; with 48% saying no
- Percentage of Don't knows is constant

Older, better educated and engaged audiences are likely to have heard of both SGD/UNSDGs


Those who are concerned for poverty in poor countries more likely to have heard of SDGs

Those who feel personally able to help people in poor countries more likely to have heard of UN SDGs

Women less likely to have heard of SDGs




## Which countries do the SDGs apply to?

But more engaged audiences and those with higher personal efficacy are less likely


## How many SDGs?

SDG4:Quelle est l'échéance fixée pour atteindre les Objectifs de développement durable ?




# Support for aid spending



## Attitudes towards ODA

- Aid helps people in poor countries and reduces migration to FR and Europe 38%
- Aid helps to stabilize countries in crisis and make FR secure 23%
- Aid increases FR's diplomatic and economic influence 17%




Migration: older, better educated, higher personal efficacy say aid helps poor + reduce migration  
FR influence: **not popular with base** (i.e. engaged, high personal efficacy, concerned)

## A closer look


Overall we observe a measurable (10%), positive, but significant improvement in attitudes towards aid spending in France from 2013 to 2018

This can be broken down to three different dynamics

- For the **average respondent**, the trend is positive and significant
- For specific groups the trend is flat (i.e. no increase/no decrease)
  - Front National/Le Pen voters
  - Those with no concern for global poverty
- The improvement in attitudes towards aid is even more marked, especially for
  - Those concerned about global poverty
  - Marginally and informationally engaged respondents




Biggest increase in support for aid spending comes from those who are concerned for poverty in poor countries

Slight increase among those with no strong feelings

Flat for those not concerned


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Biggest increase in support for aid spending comes from those who informationally and marginally engaged


There are also increases for behaviourally and fully engaged - but keep in mind these groups are very small and so the estimates are less precise

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Across the political parties there is a general upward trend, save for Le Rassemblement National

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Young people (18-29) show greater support for aid spending compared to 30+

However, age differences are not independent predictors of support – they get taken over by other factors (i.e. attitudes)

## Group differences

If we look at characteristics one by one, a small difference emerges for age groups, with younger people showing a more marked improvement in attitudes in more recent years

However, age, gender, education, income, region are not significant in the multivariate analysis, showing that the overall positive trend isn't being driven by individuals with different demographic characteristics

More evidence that support for aid is based on attitudes, values and beliefs – rather than social demographics
