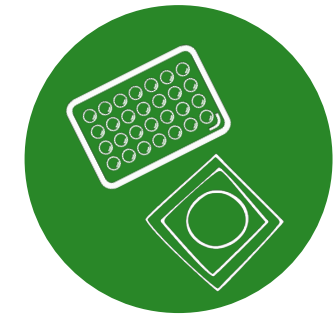

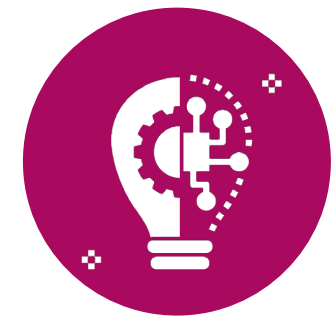

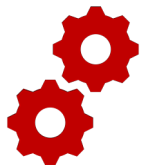

Figures are expressed as a percentage. For some questions asked exclusively to men or women, the sample is around 1000 respondents.

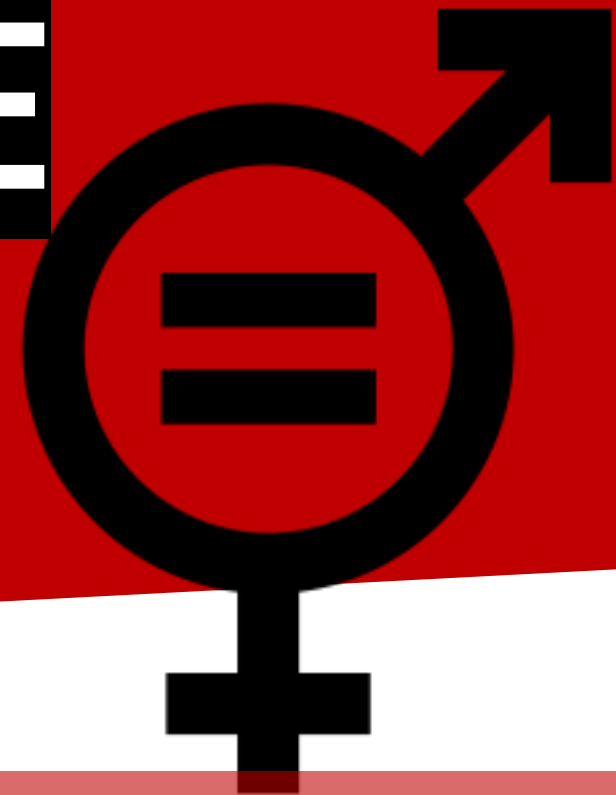
CONSIDERING EQUALITY BETWEEN WOMEN AND MEN AS AN AXIS OF OBSERVATION :

- ✓ Women consistently demonstrate a **higher sensitivity** than men. Their points of **view are not opposed** but **more emphasized**.
- ✓ A large **majority of men are aware of the issue of equality** : men are aware of inequalities, of the need for change and the majority of them are in favour of change.
- ✓ The usual socio-demographic determinants are **not as effective as what is generally observed on DEL in relation to development issues**.
- ✓ Differences in positioning are more **centered on life stages** and **generational variations**
- ✓ Counterintuitively, **older respondents** are, for example, **more aware of gender equality than middle-aged people**.
- ✓ The slightly **greater sensitivity of left-wing supporters** to equality represents **nothing more than a trend**.
- ✓ Whatever the point of view, whether cultural or ideological, in France, **gender equality is a struggle which is mostly understood, accepted, expected or requested**. Since opponents to gender equality are never the majority, the legitimacy of (an almost radical) change is probably increasingly proven.
- ✓ The consequences of gender inequality are spontaneously highlighted concerning **issues of violence** (physical and mental), **economic issues** (unequal pay) and **professional positioning issues** (access to management positions).

- ✓ **50% of the population** acknowledges that gender **equality** has **improved both in the world and in France**.
 - ✓ **50% of French people** consider **religion** to be an **obstacle to achieving equality in developing countries** compared to 28% in France.
 - ✓ **45% of French people** believe that we **can not end world poverty without resolving gender inequalities**.
 - ✓ **59% of French people** want France to **increase its financial contribution** to advance **women's rights in developing countries**
 - ✓ **61% of French people** think that **supporting gender equality** should be a **priority for French development aid**.
 - ✓ **61% of French people** approve of the idea of a **feminist diplomacy**.
 - ✓ **68% of French people** recognize that women and men are not equal in reality.
 - ✓ **40% of French people** consider themselves **feminists** (compared to 47% who do not consider themselves feminists).
 - ✓ **61% of French people** believe that the introduction of **parity in decision-making bodies** is a good way to **improve gender equality** in France.

- ✓ **49% of French people** recognise that **the government is involved** (very much or somewhat) in advancing **gender equality**.
 - ✓ **73% of French people** believe that France should **increase the budget allocated to prevent feminicides**.
 - ✓ **23% of French people** think that **women can trust the justice system** to protect them from **violence against them**.
 - ✓ For **55% of French people**, the choice of the **sex of their first child does not matter**.
 - ✓ **12% of men and 27% of women** consider that women **cannot refuse to have sexual relations** with their **spouse**.
 - ✓ **26% of women** acknowledge having suffered **violence** from being a woman.
 - ✓ **16% of men** admit that they have **not always behaved** with some **women**.
 - ✓ **49% of men** declare that they are now **more vigilant** than before with regard to **women's rights**.
 - ✓ **64% of French people** recognize that women **often earn lower wages** than men.

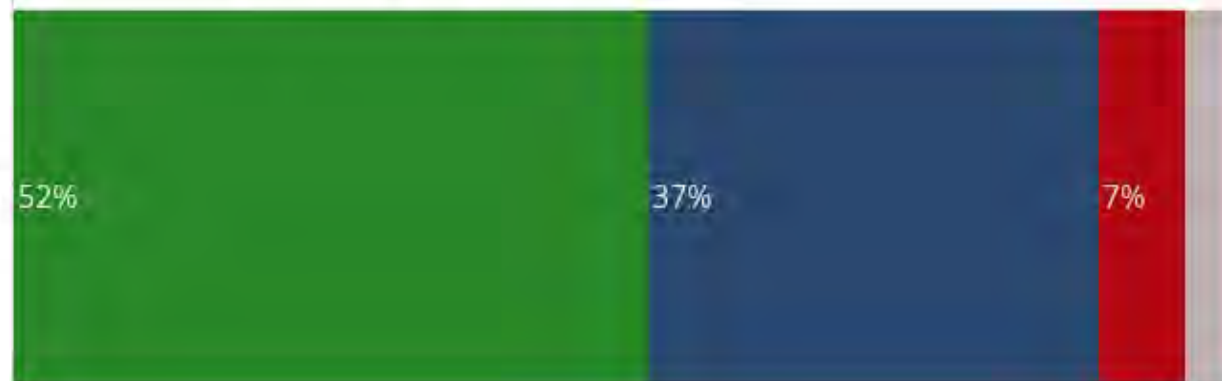


In your view, compared to 25 years ago, is equality between women and men in France:

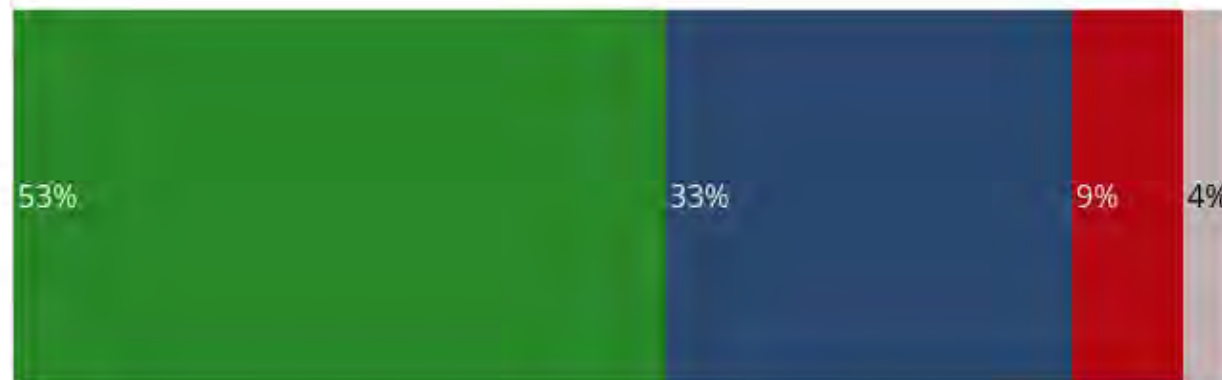

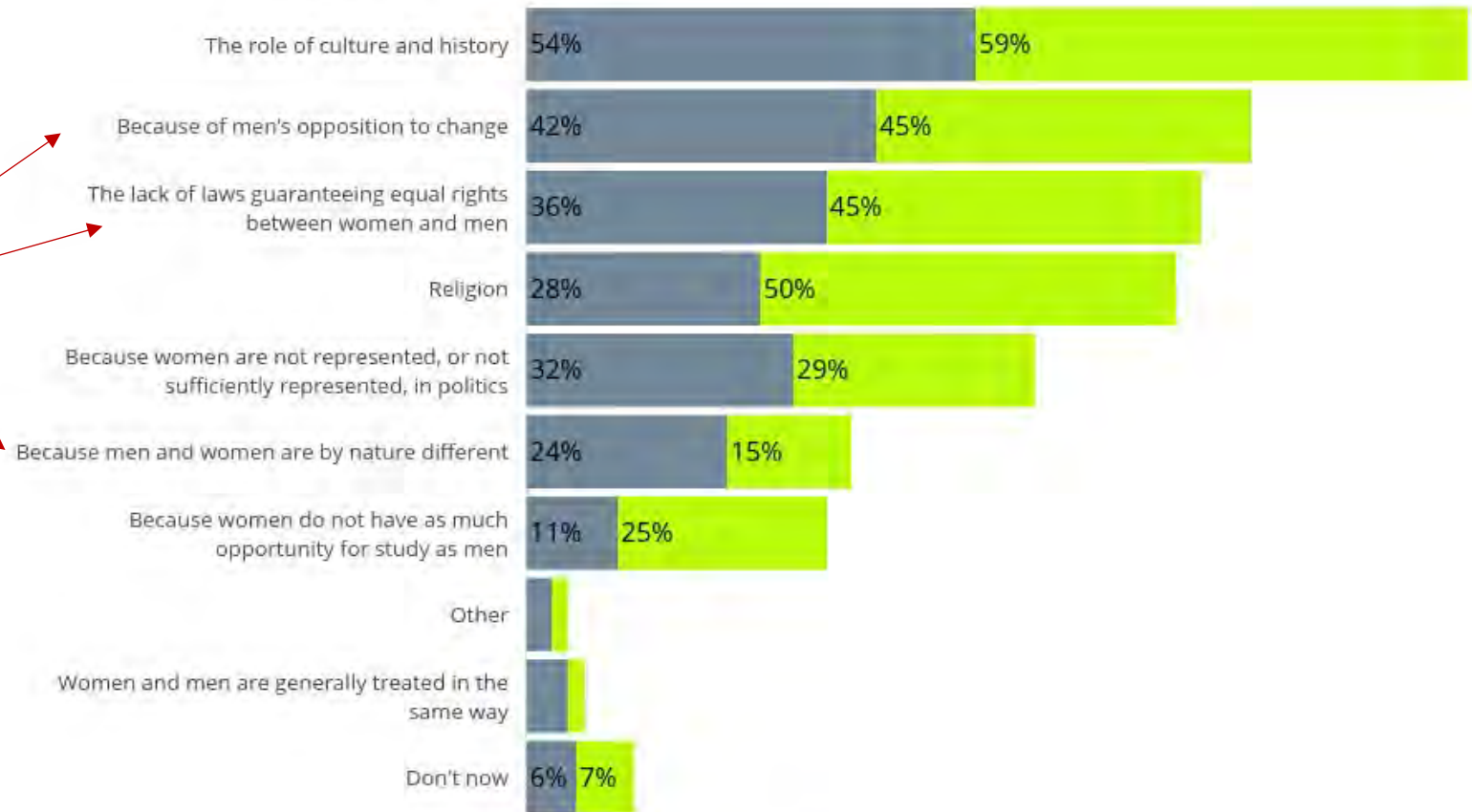

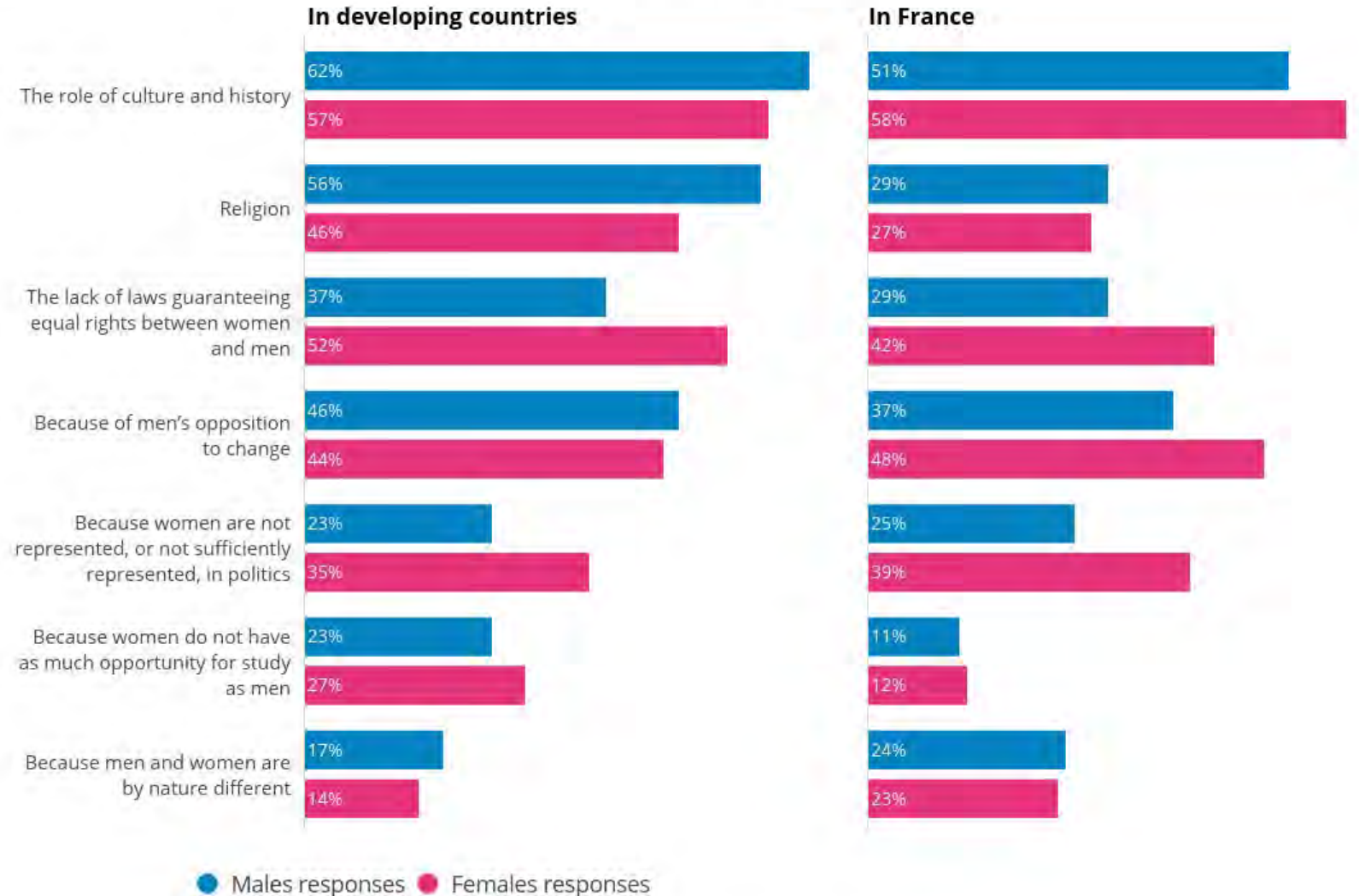

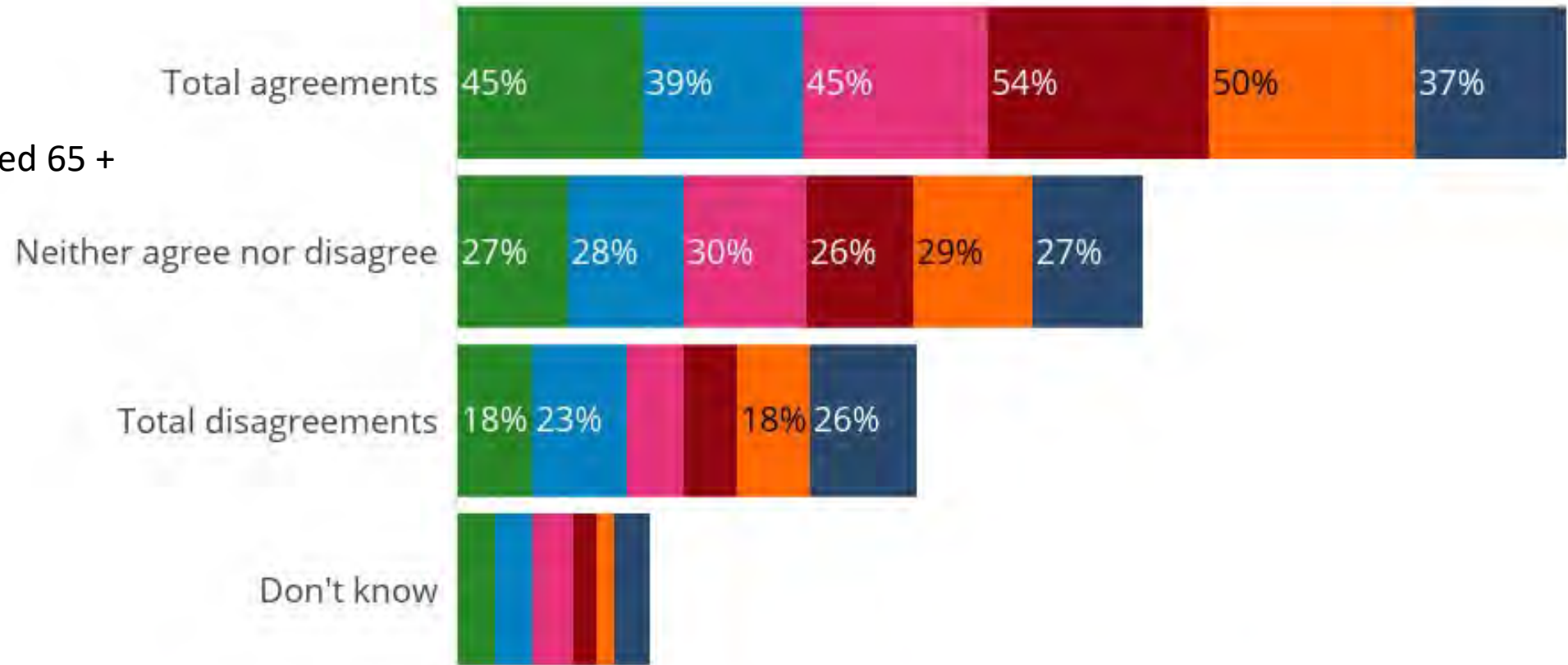

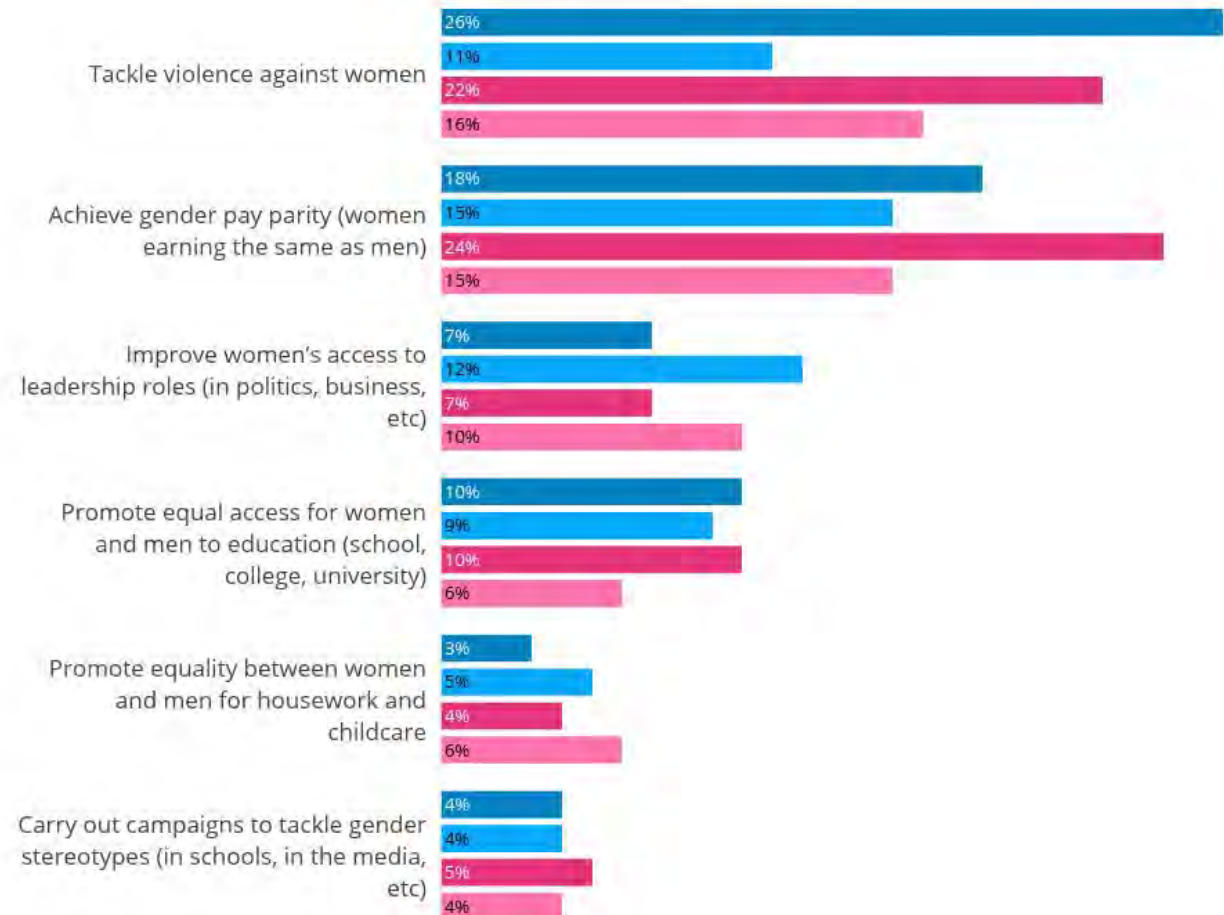

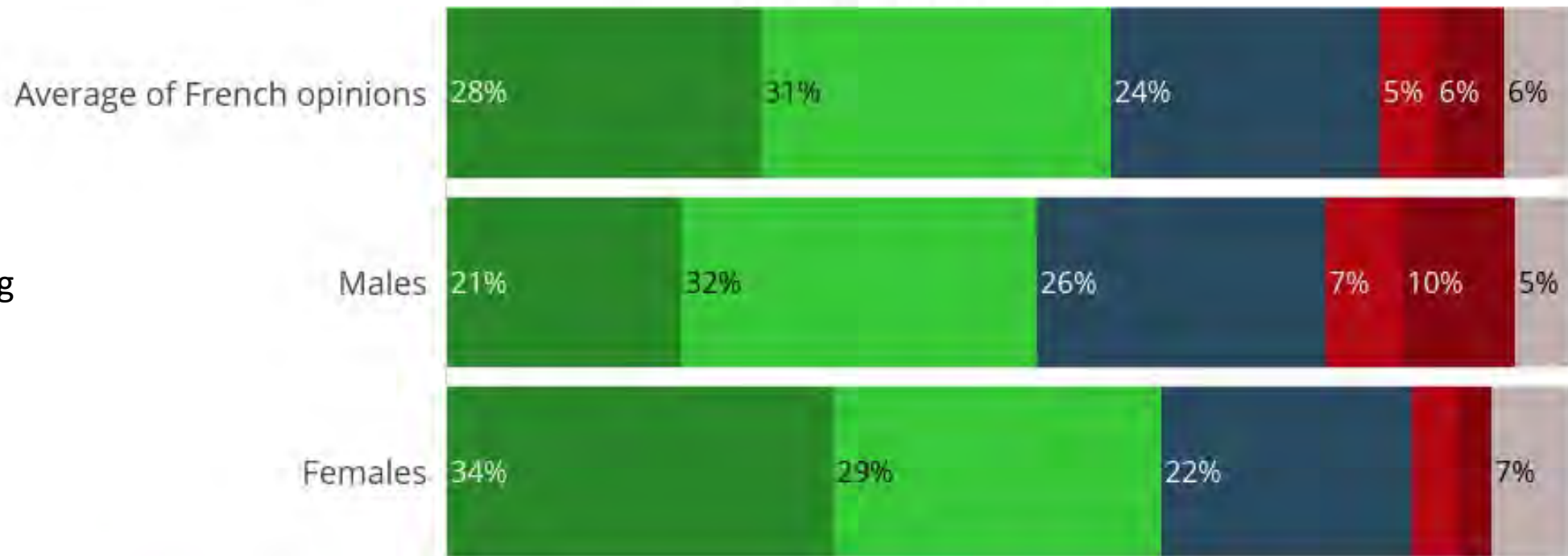

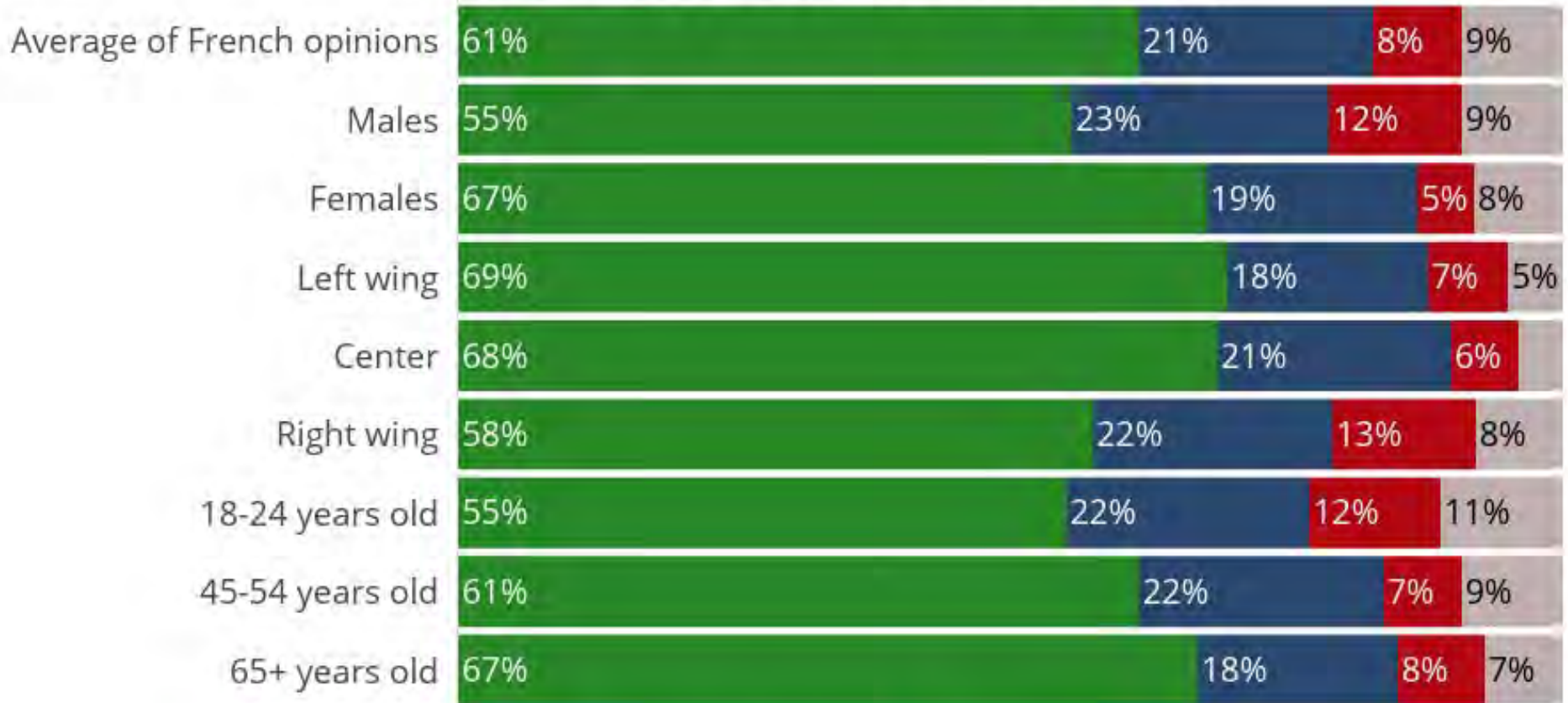

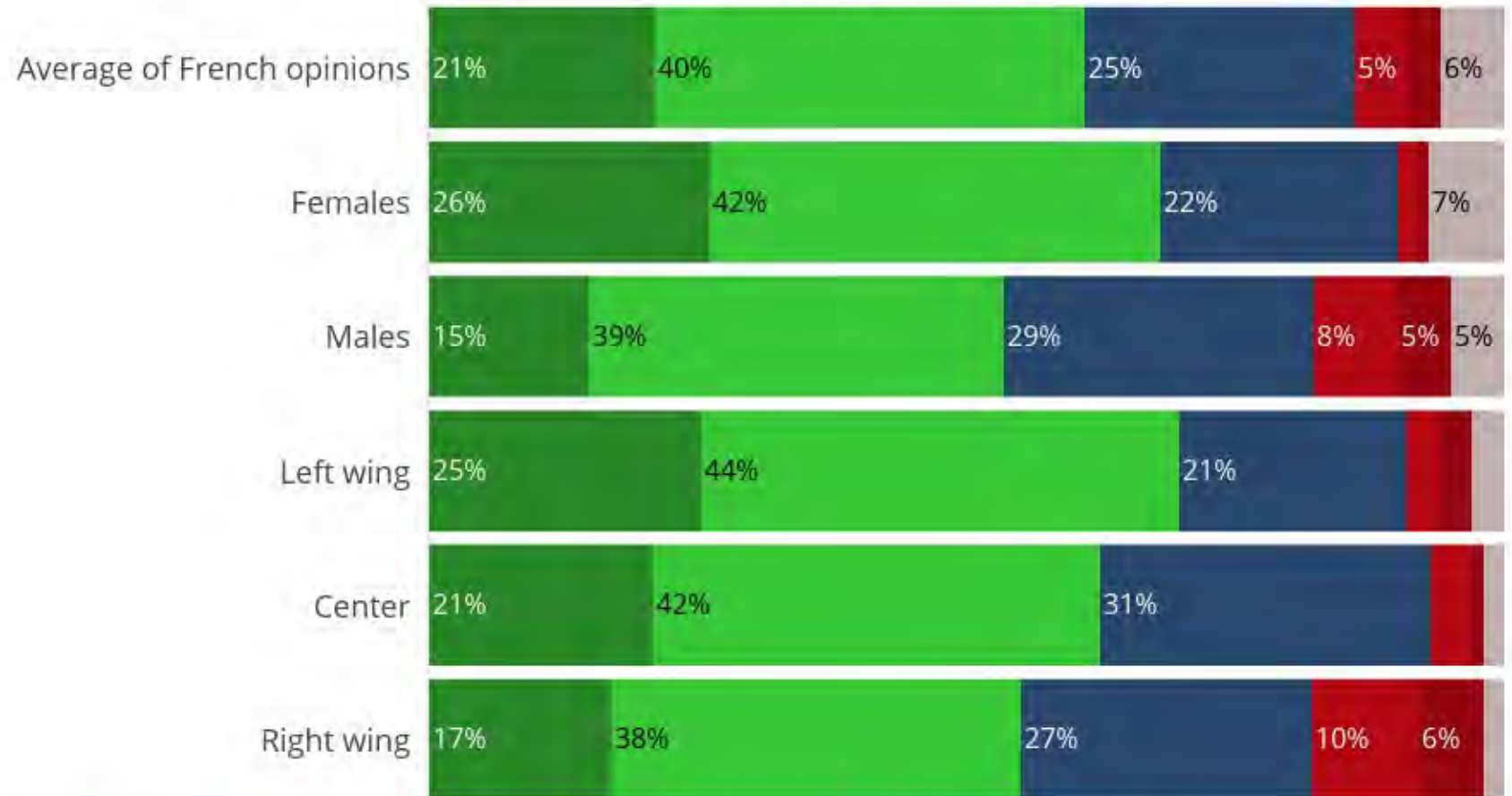

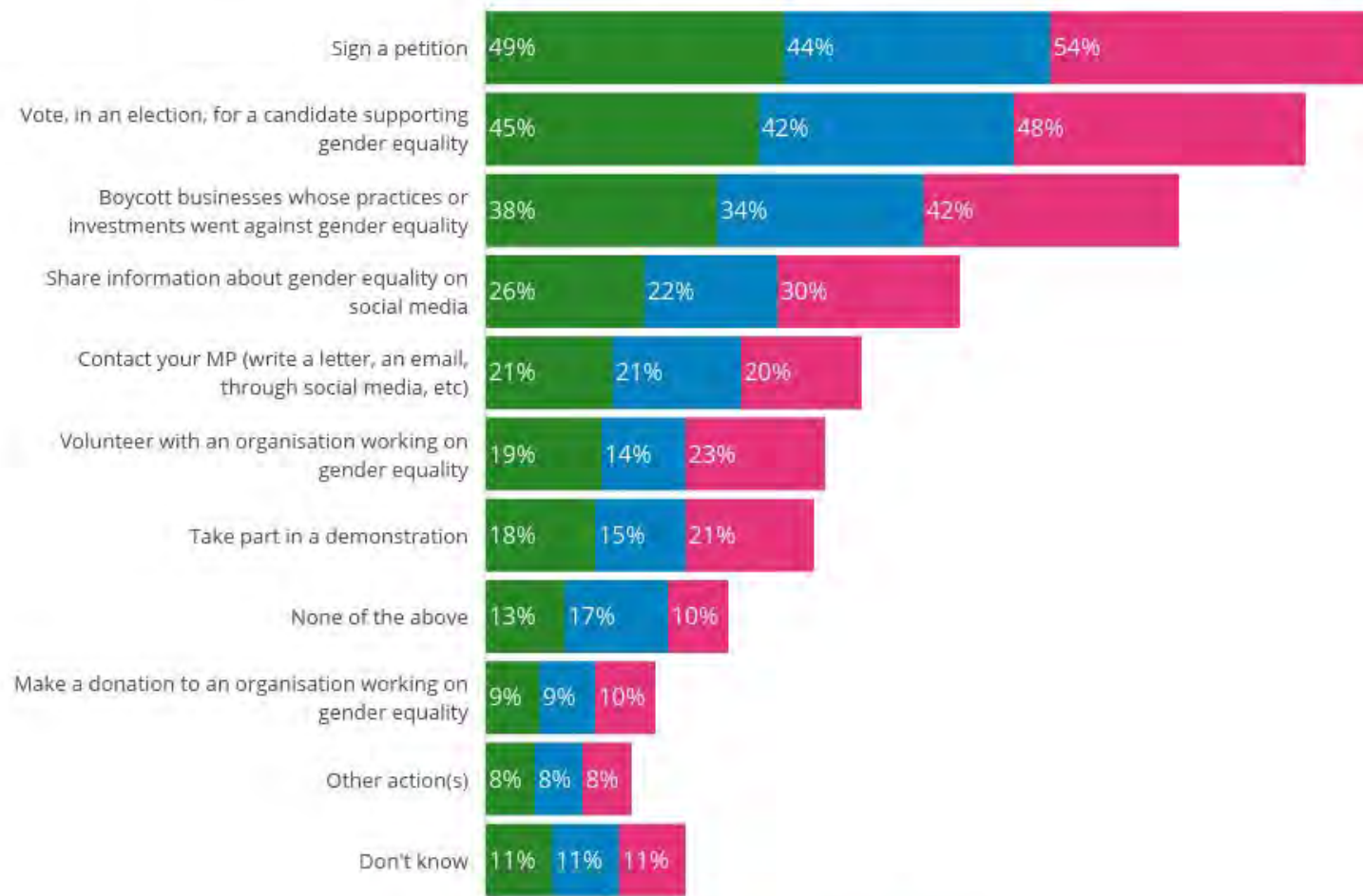

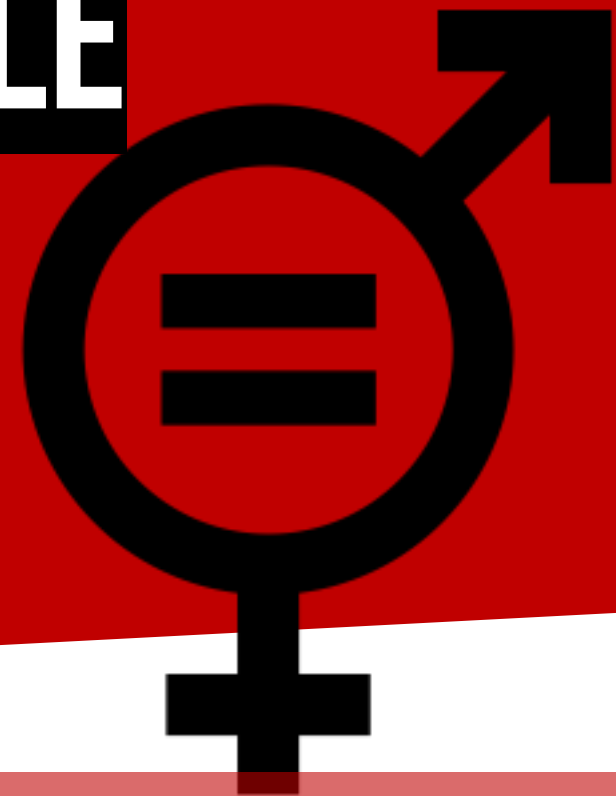

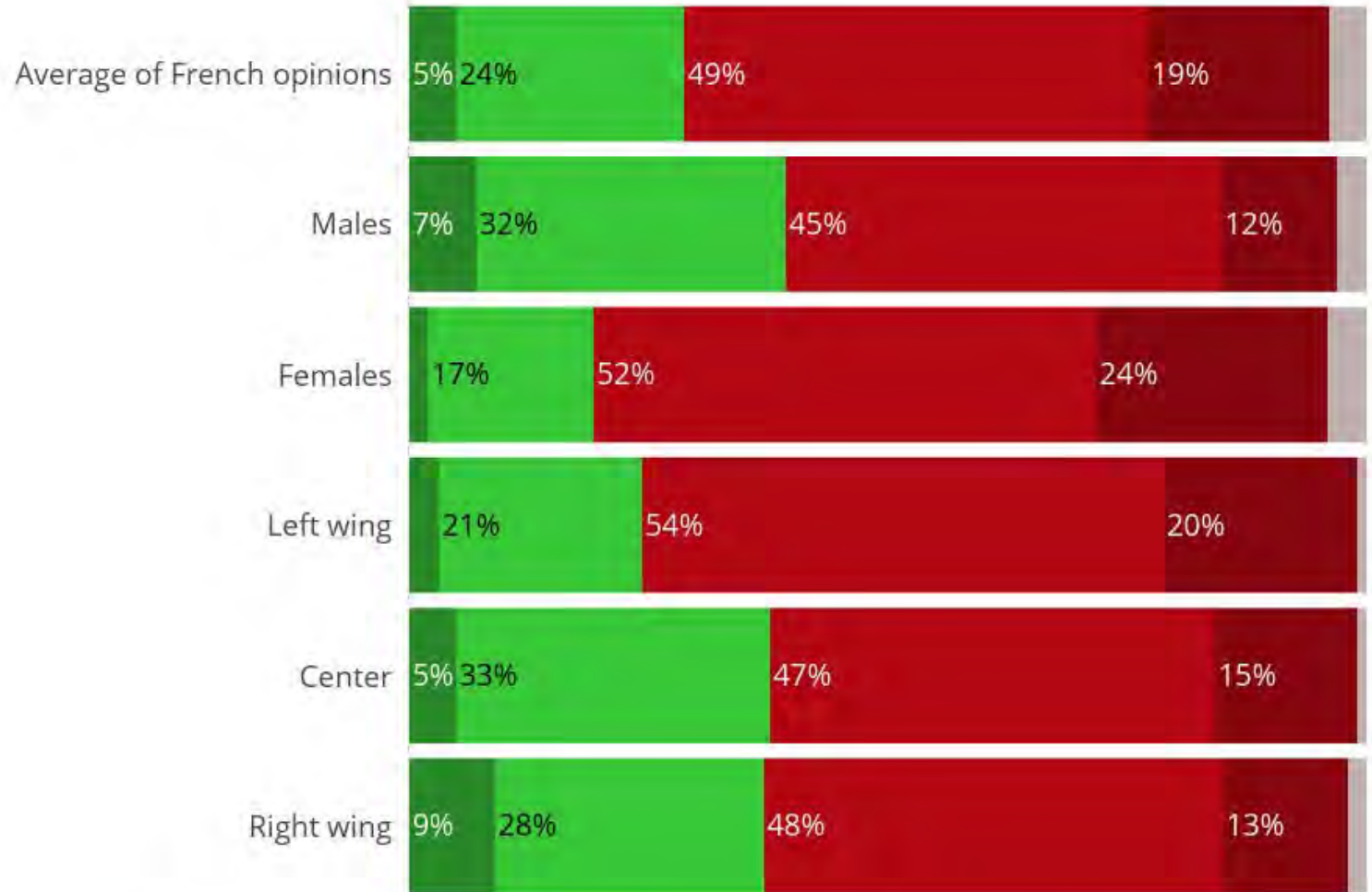

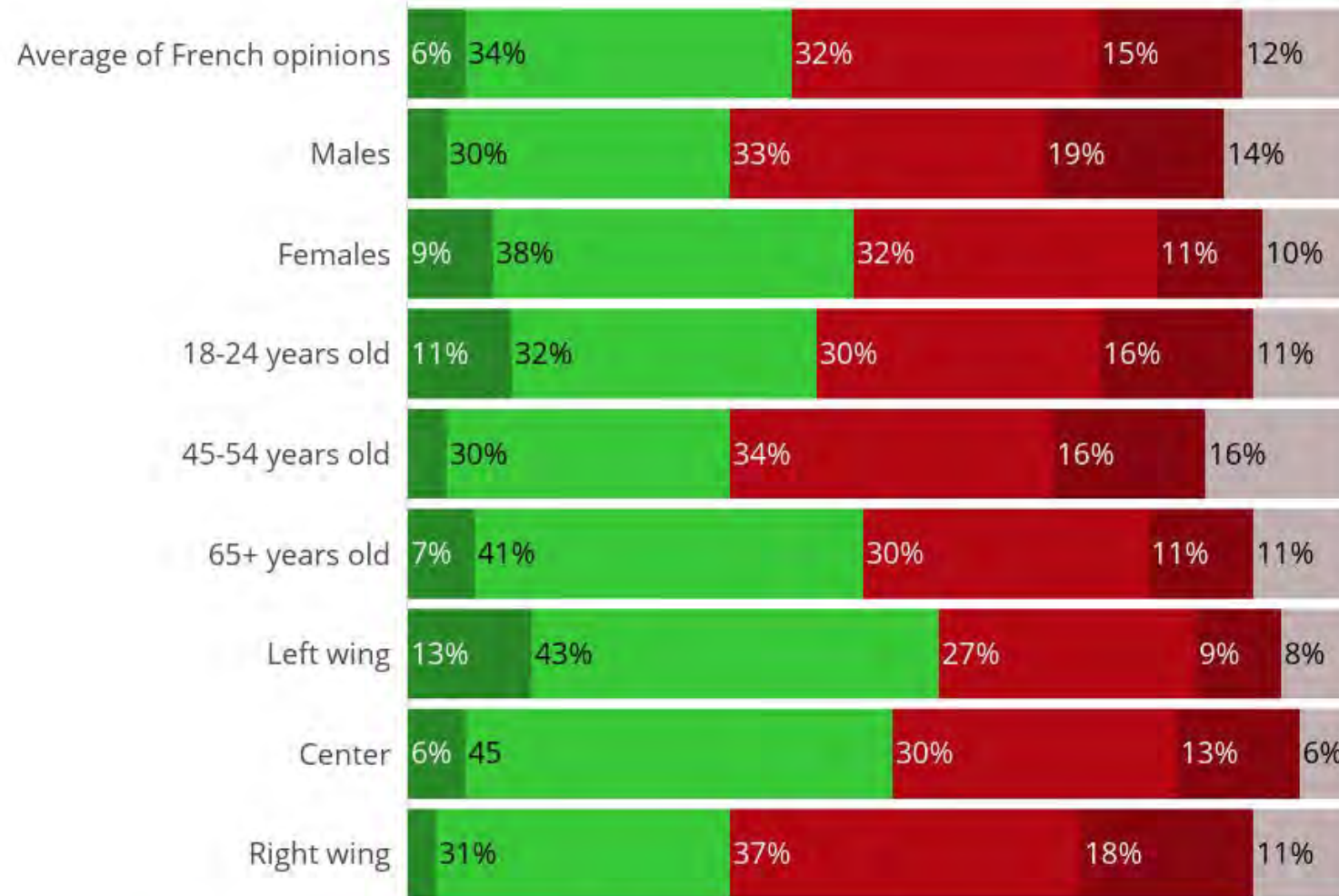

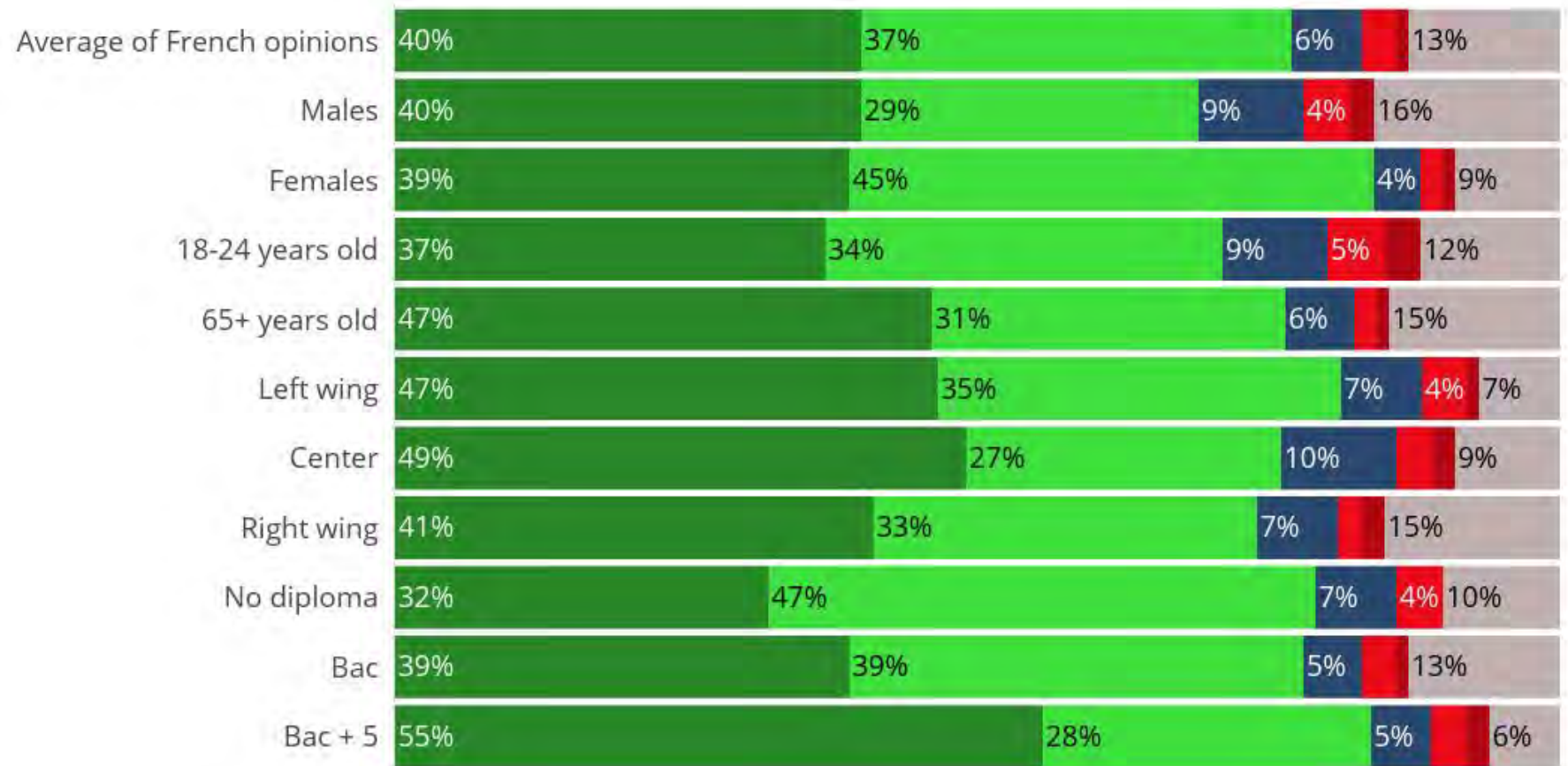

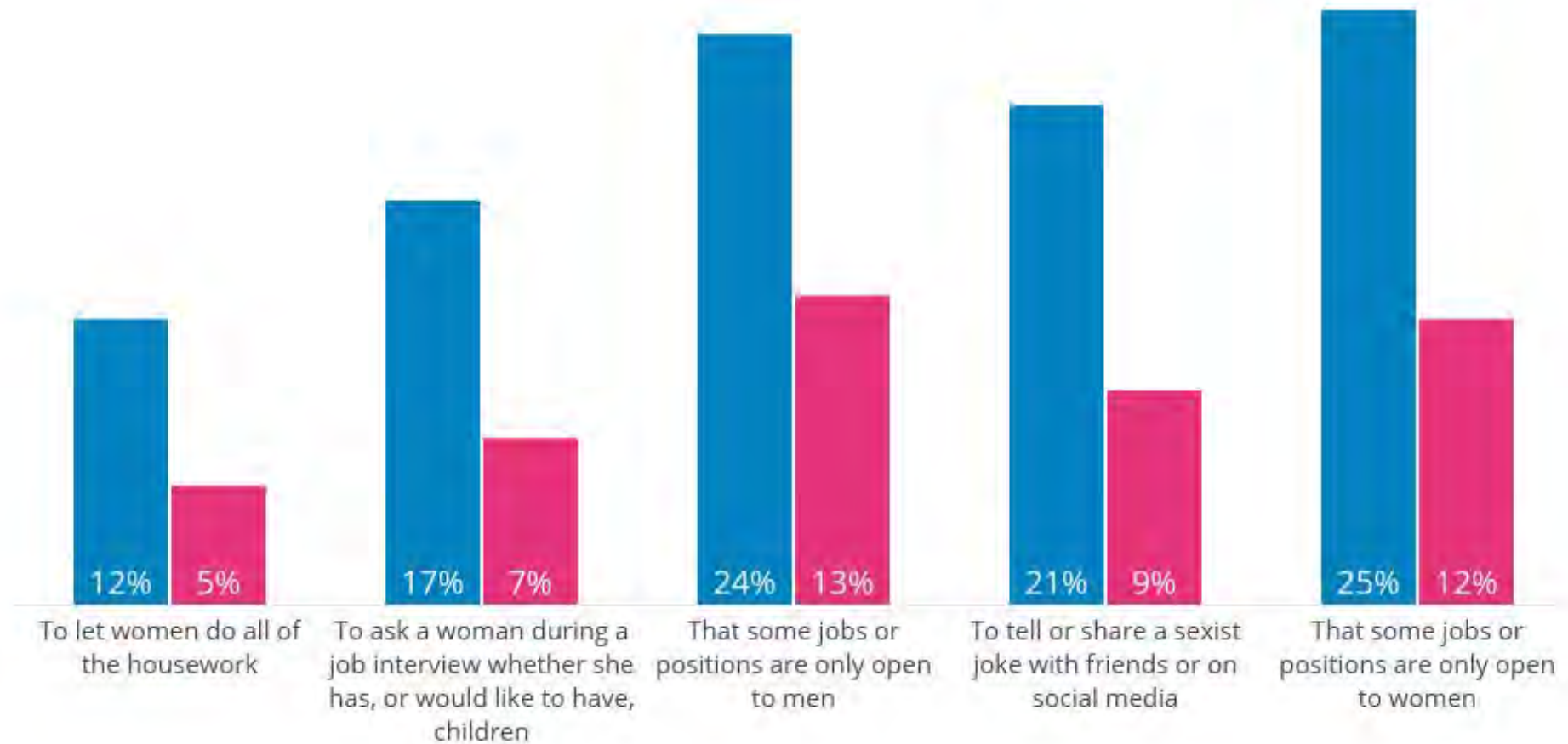

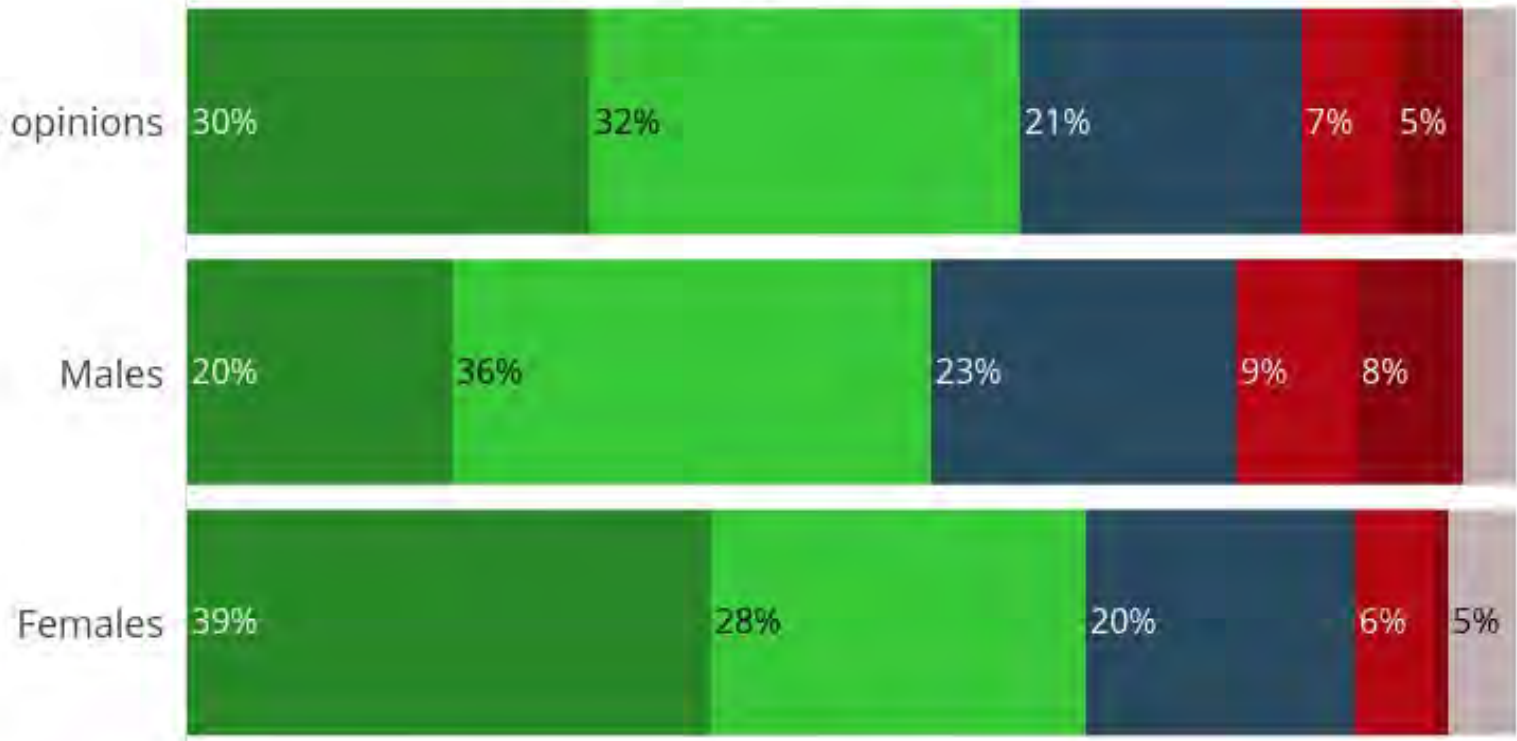

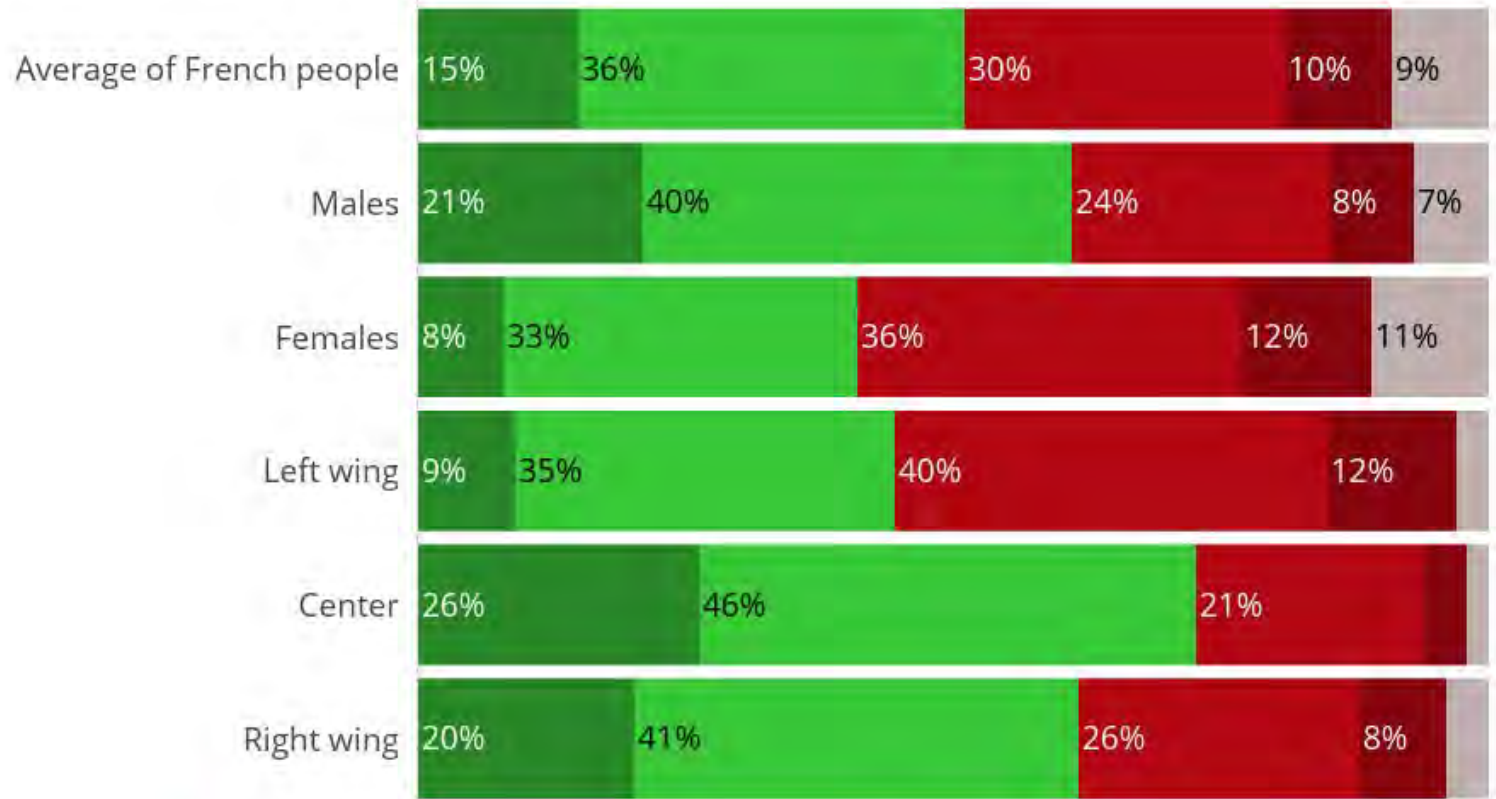

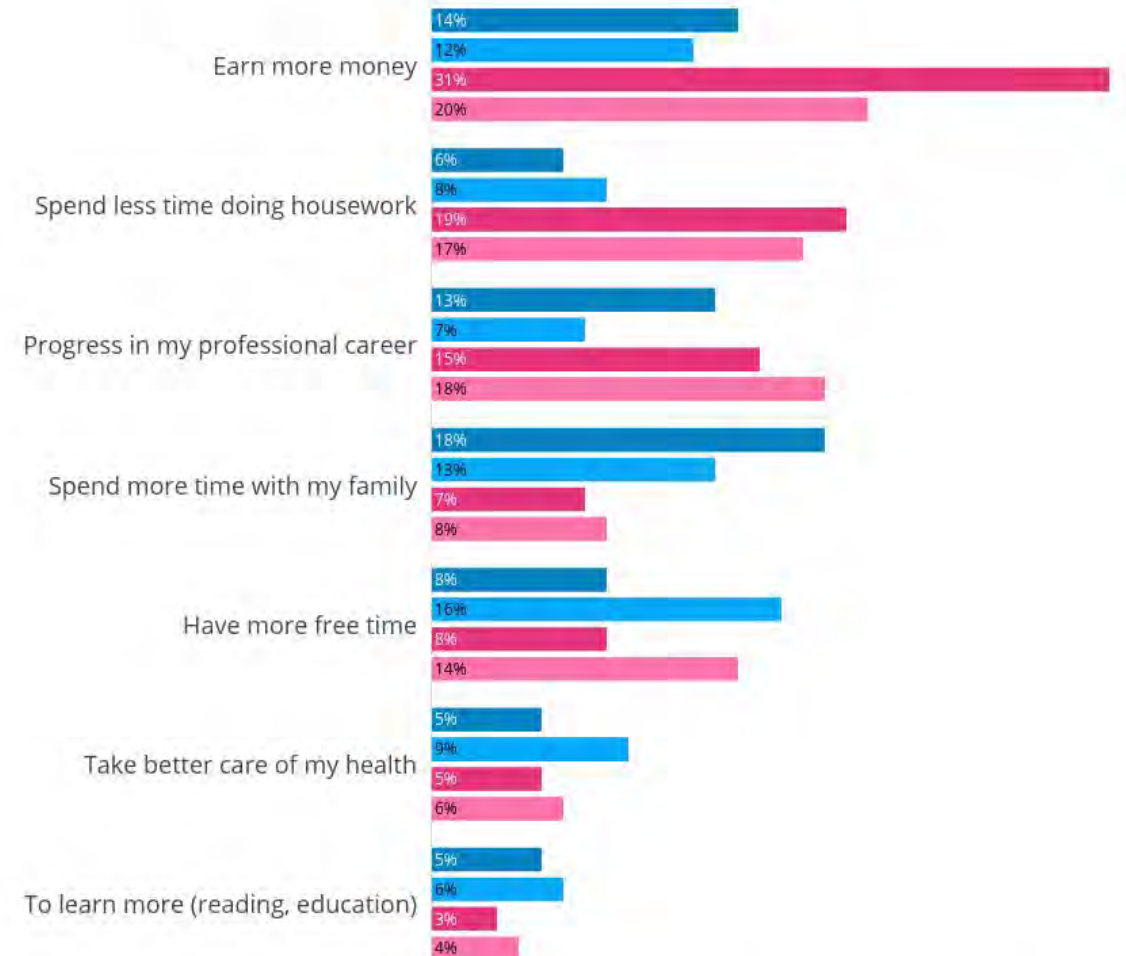

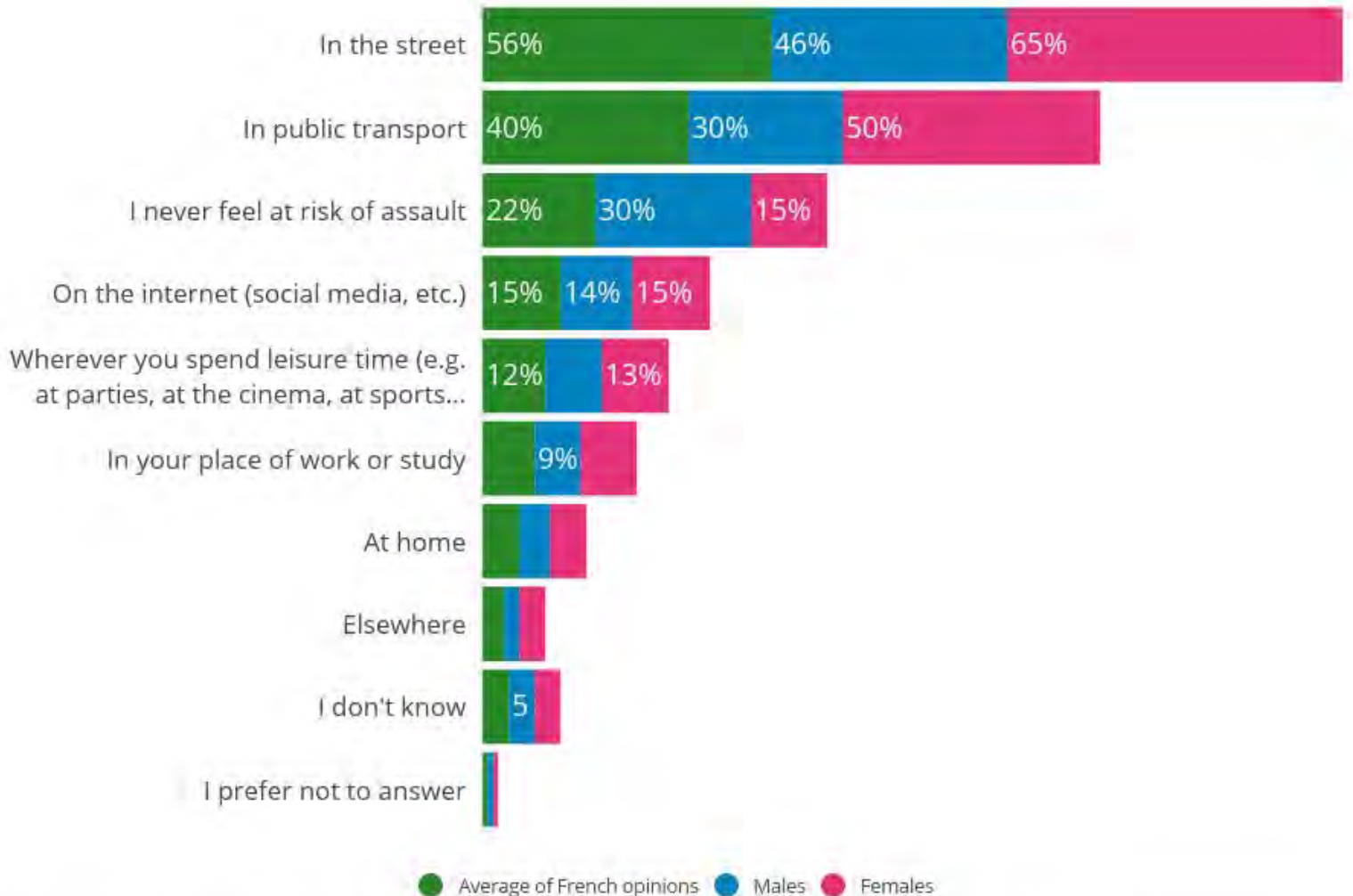

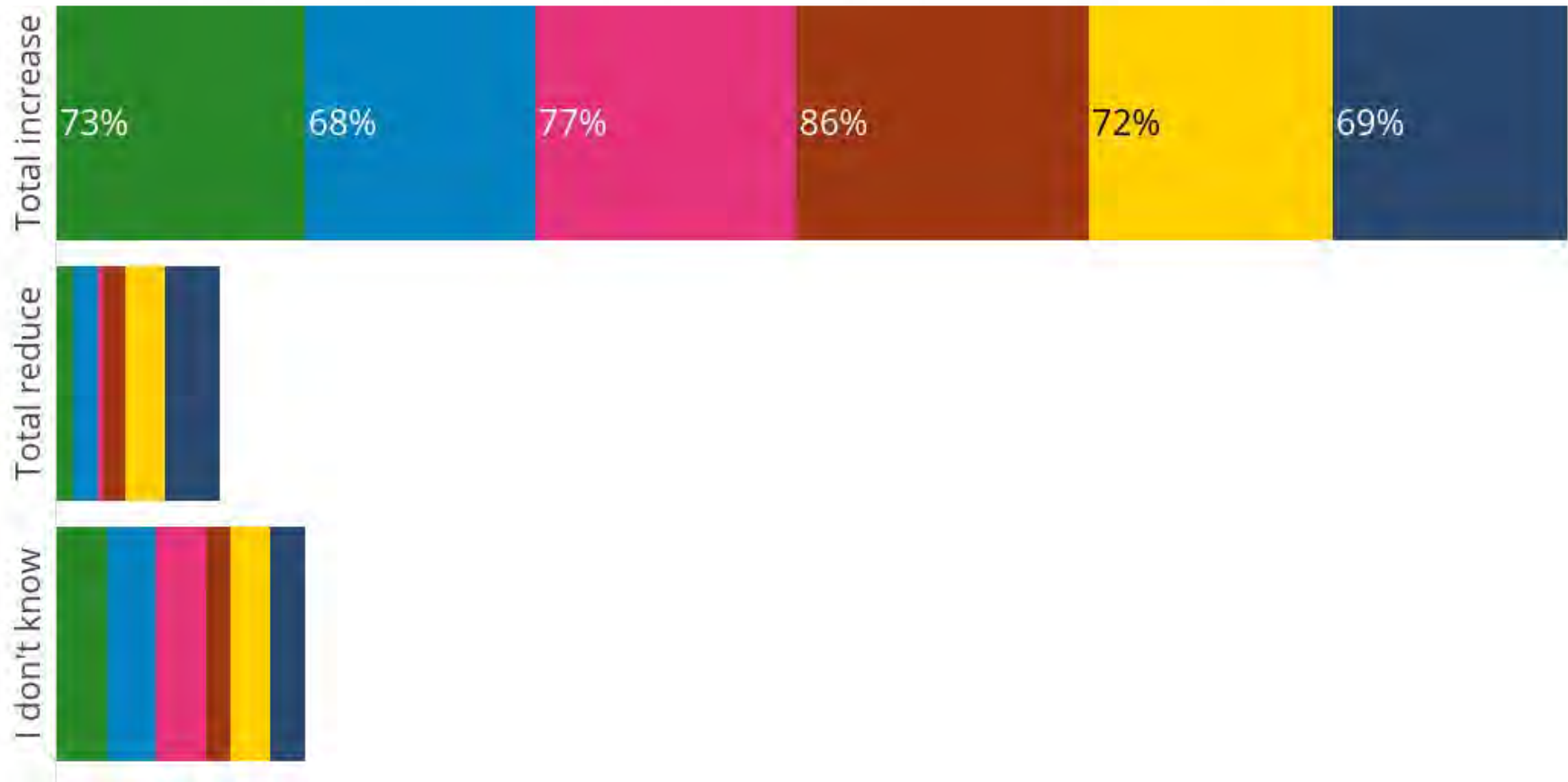

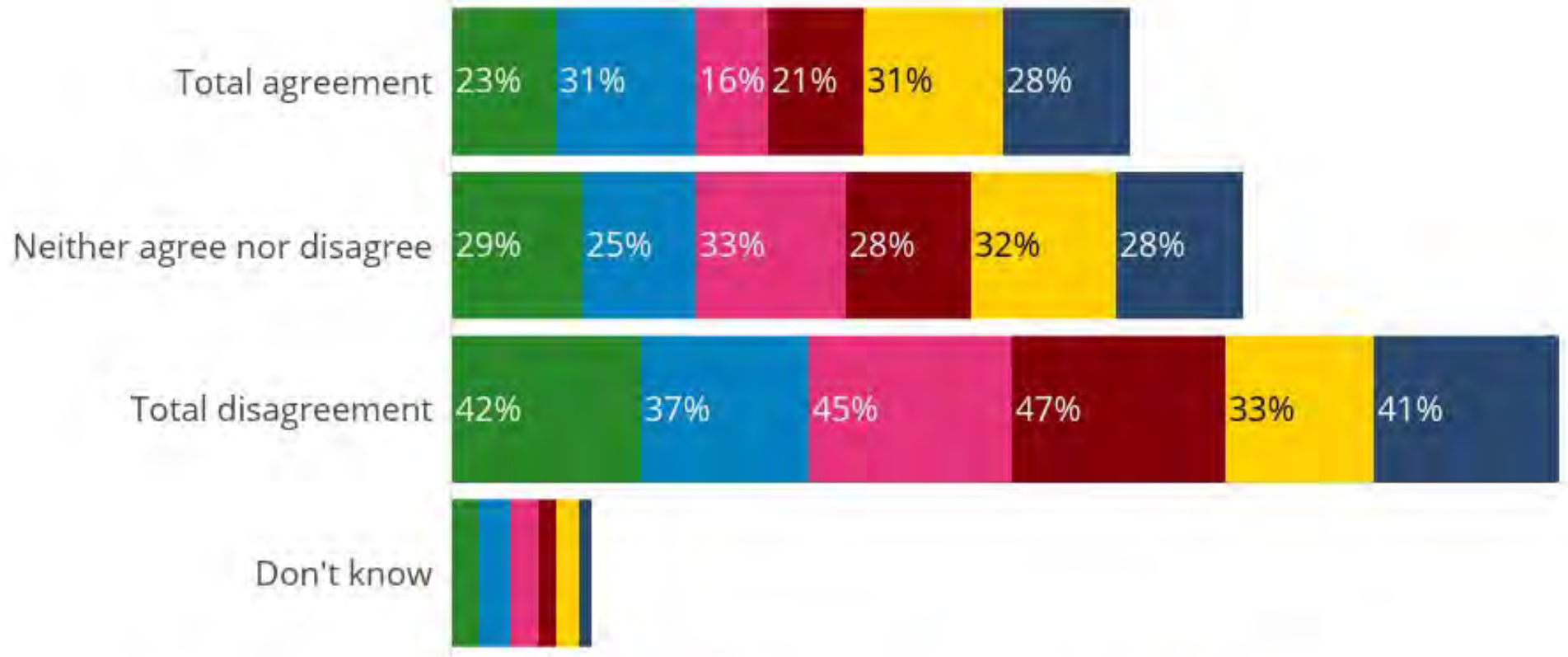

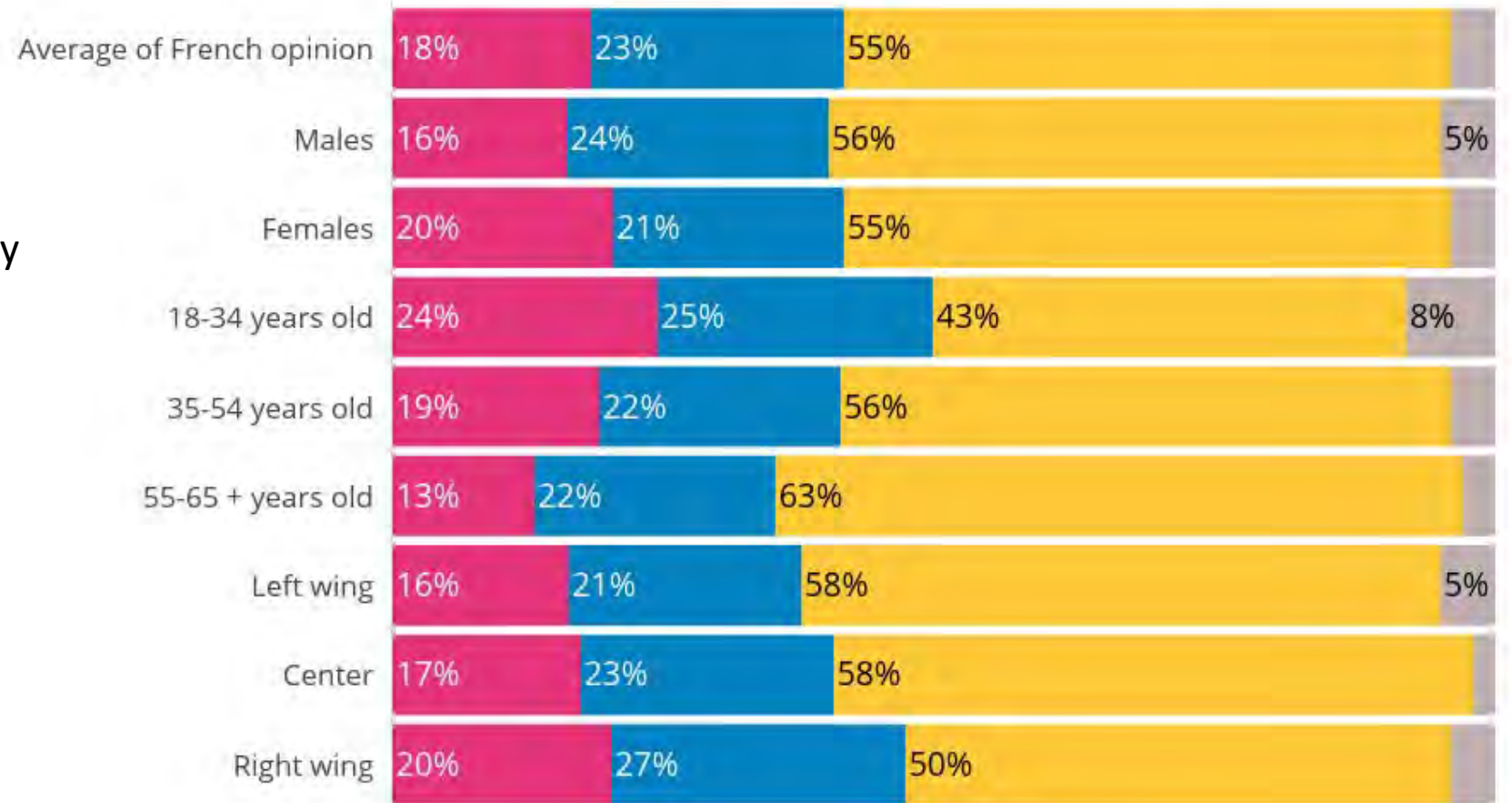

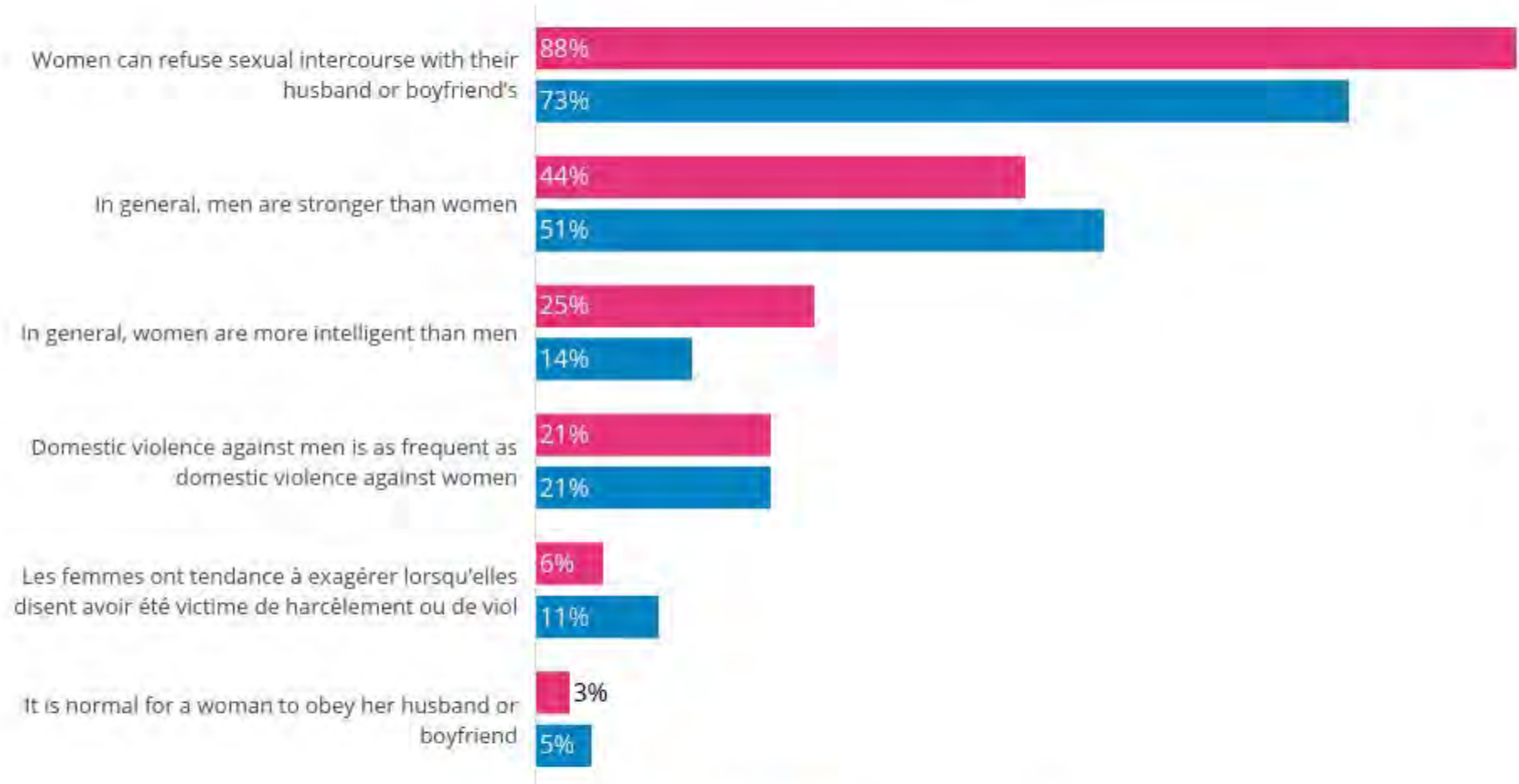

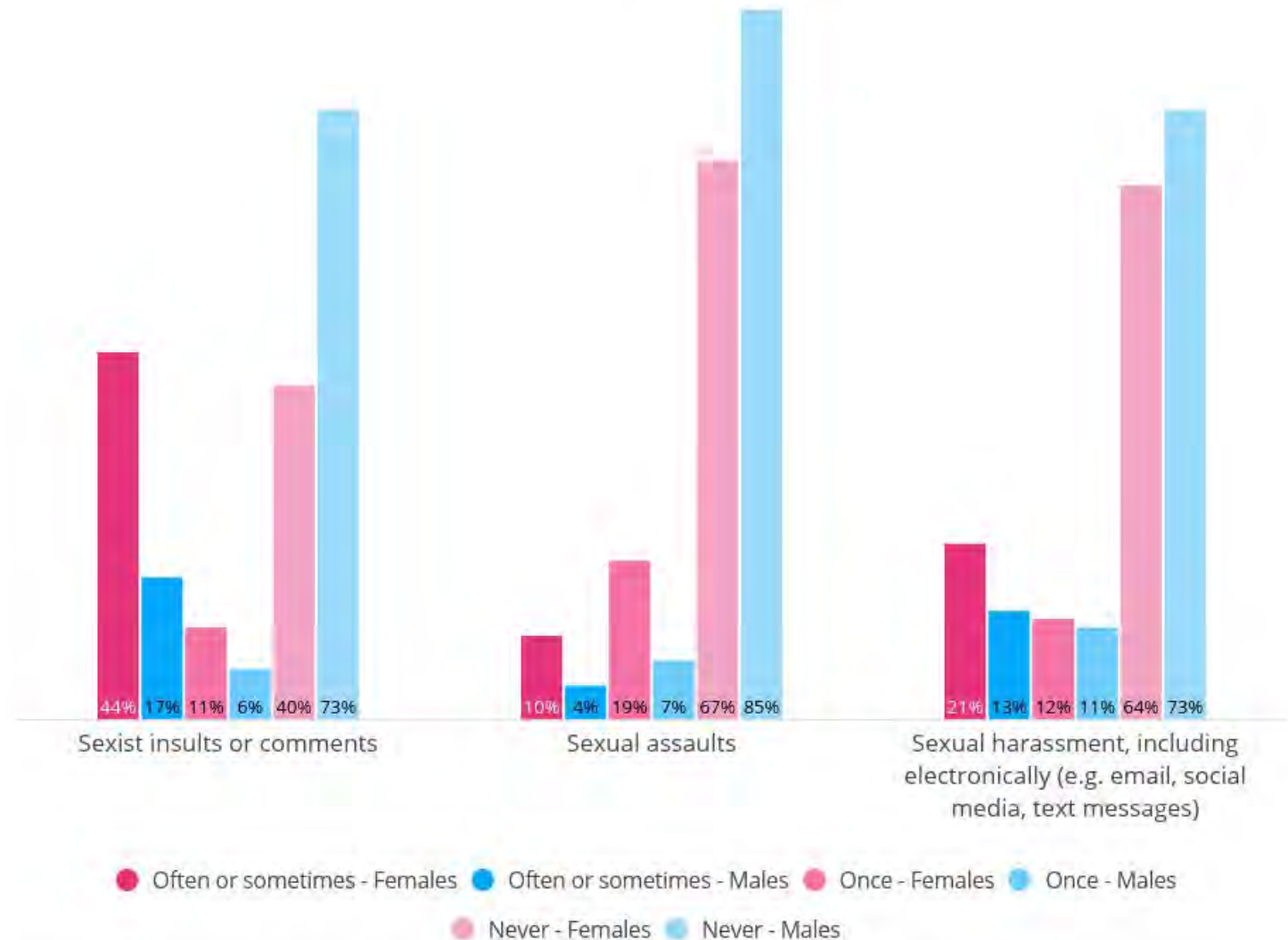

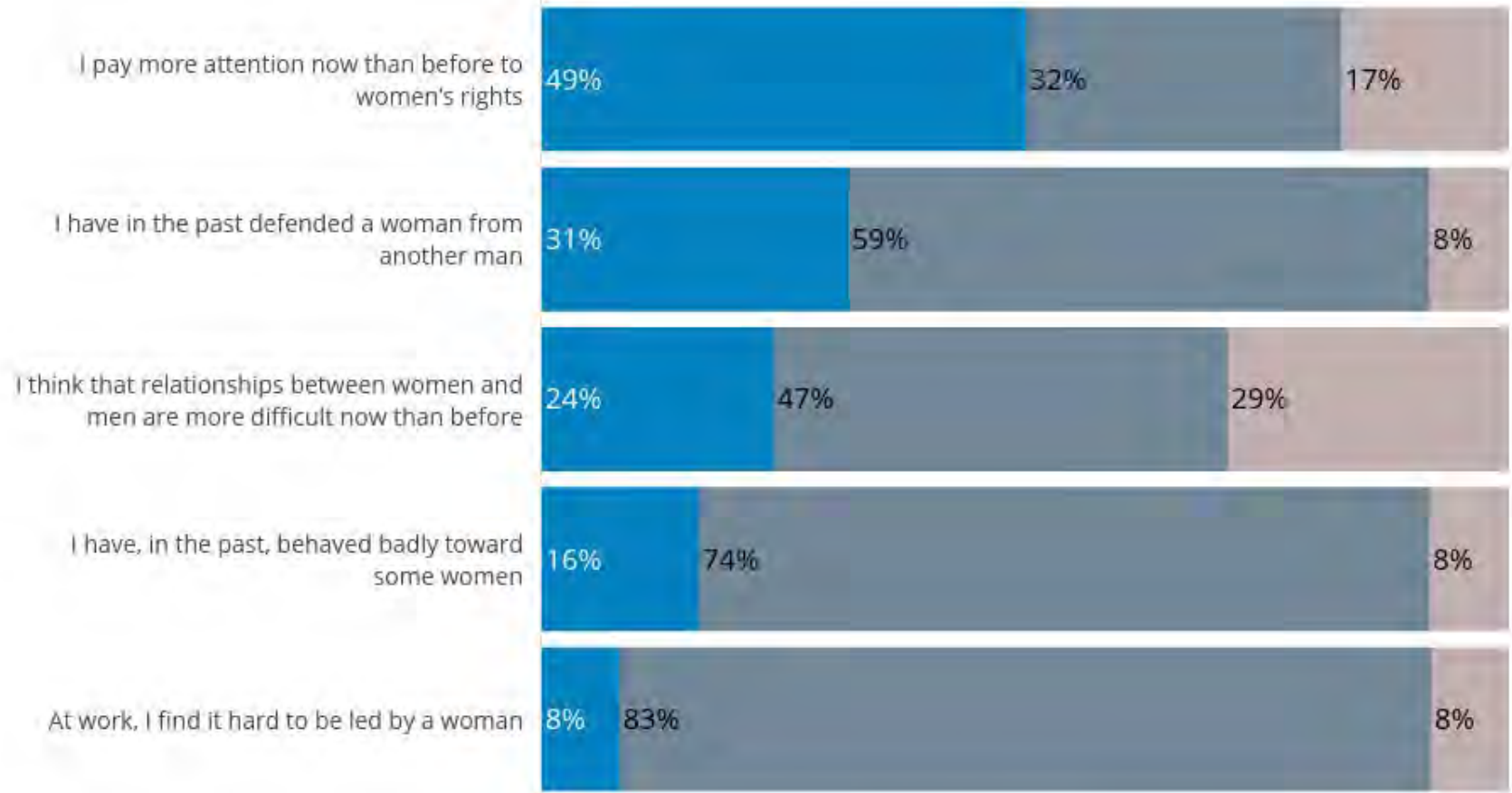

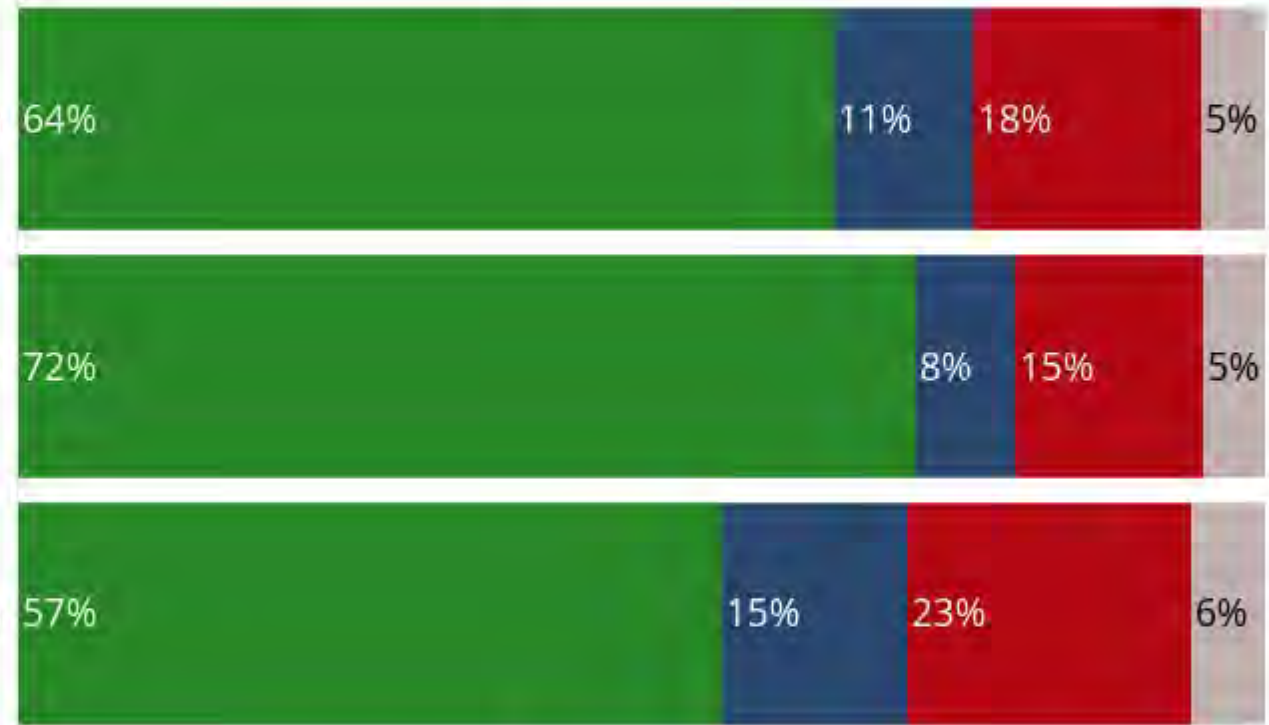

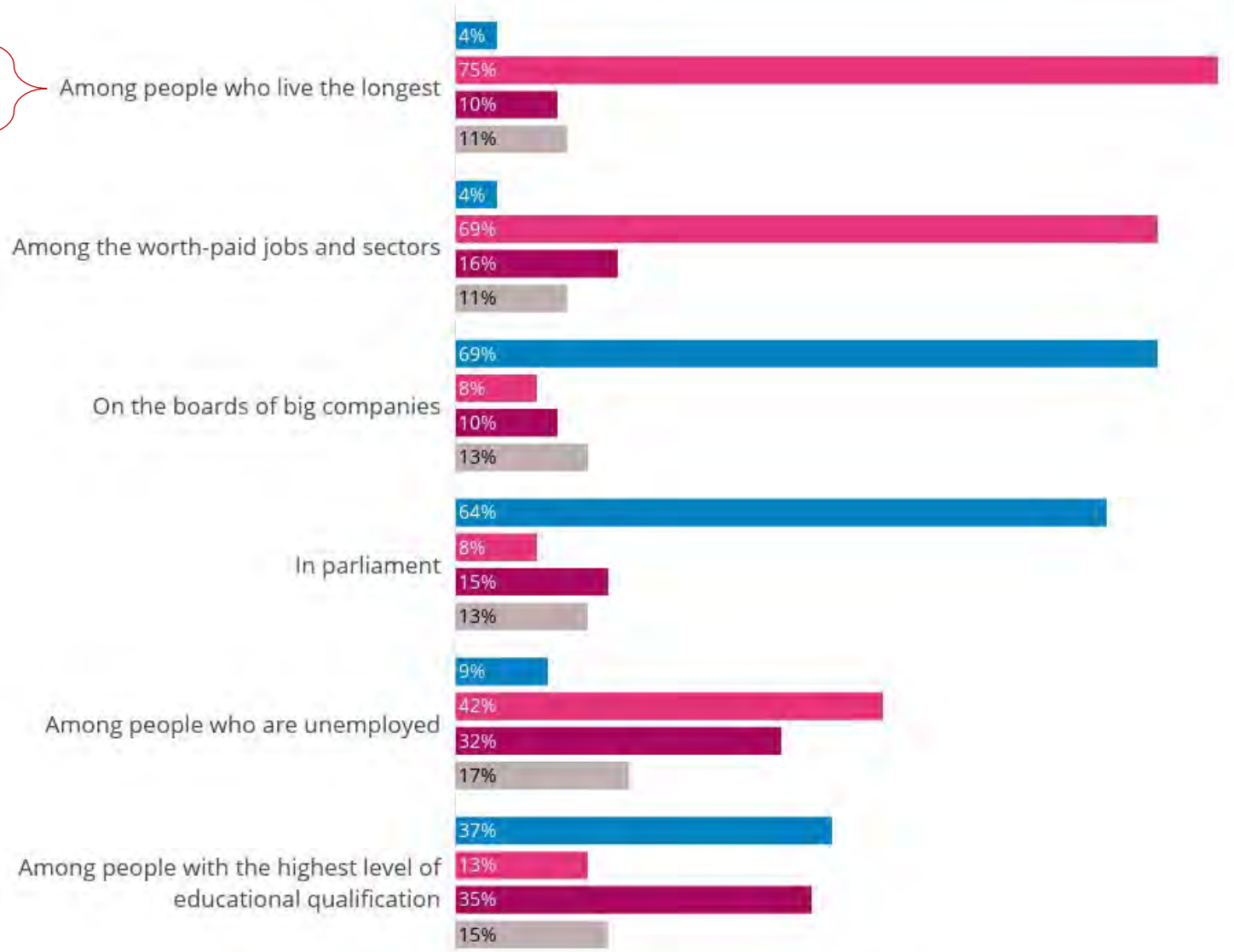
